

FRUIT AND VEGETABLE SUPPLY REACHES PEAK ON PORTLAND MARKET

PORTLAND, July 3.—(P)—Summer fruits and vegetables have reached their peak at the East Side market maintained by the Farmers and Ranchers' association. Below is today's range of prices:

Loganberries, \$1.25 to \$2.50 a crate; celery, \$1 dozen bunches; lettuce, 7c to 11c crate; strawberries, \$1.50 to \$1.60 crate; blackberries, \$2.50 to \$2.75 crate; currants, \$1.25 dozen; new potatoes, 3 1/2c pound; old potatoes, 2c sack; cabbage 3 1/2c pound; new peas, 5c pound; old peas, 3 1/2c; carrots, 2c dozen bunches; beets, 25c dozen bunches; seed onions, 25c; raspberries, \$2.75 crate; currants, \$1.65 crate.

Since the dairy exchange ceased operations, eggs and butter quotations were up in the air. Hereafter action on these will be those given for the retail trade at the Yamhill market by the city market master. Wholesale prices usually range one to three or more cents above these.

Wall Street Report

NEW YORK, July 3.—(P)—Heavy selling of the public utility shares, several of which dropped two to six points, temporarily unsettled today's stock market, which was again pointed to higher ground.

Curiously, the low prices of the day were recorded after the call money rate had dropped from 12 to 8 per cent, but strong buying support made its appearance, particularly in the so-called "Money stocks" and the market was headed upward again in the early afternoon.

Radio, inactive recently, was taken hold of in the final hour and lifted to 30, the highest in a month. Prices of many other leaders responded to a further drop in the call money rate to six per cent. Auburn auto source 15 points to a record price, while American (Gen. Southern Pacific), Old Elevator and Texas and Pacific Railroad gained from 3 to 6 points. The closing was strong while total sales approximated 4,500,000 shares.

WINNEPEG, July 3.—(P)—Another bullish movement struck the wheat market today, sending prices five cents higher with the July future selling at \$1.29 1/2, the highest mark for the crop season. October wheat at noon was selling 3 1/2c higher at \$1.35 and the December 2 1/2c above yesterday's close at \$1.32 1/2.

TRADES SAVINGS FOR COMIC STRIP

HOQUIAM, Wash., July 3.—(P)—Chris Zahnd, 76, withdrew \$2950 from a savings bank here and traded the money to two young men for two \$1 bills and a bunch of comic strips.

The bank, same used varied but slightly from one preferred for years, officers said. One of the men Zahnd met a few weeks ago. They decided to go into business together, the acquaintance putting in \$7000. He introduced another man to Zahnd who was to invest \$25,000.

AMBASSADOR HERRICK ESTATE GOES TO SON

CLEVELAND, Ohio, July 3.—(P)—The American hospital in Paris and the Herrick public library at Wellington, Ohio, were left a total of \$85,000 by the late Ambassador Myron T. Herrick, according to the terms of his will filed in probate court today.

After many local and family bequests the residue of the estate was left to the state's son, Parkman W. Herrick. The total gross value of the estate was estimated at \$1,200,000, while the net value after all charges is set at \$750,000. Parkman Herrick was named sole executor.

Ambassador Herrick, who also served as governor of Ohio, died at his post at Paris last March 31.
