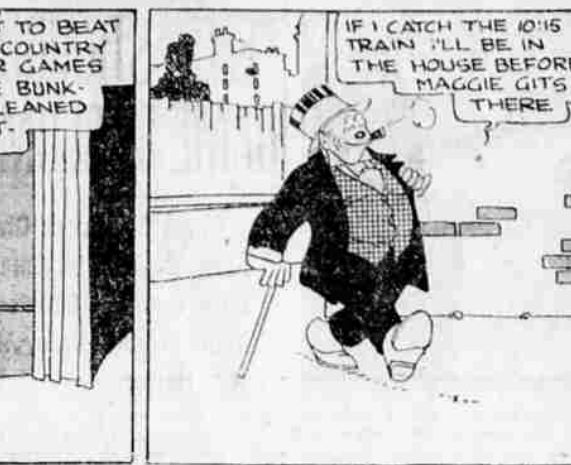

Wall Street Report

NEW YORK, July 6.—(AP)—The stock market encountered rather heavy week-end profit-taking in today's two hour session, but a vigorous resumption of bullish operations in the rail and some of the specialties checked the decline and losses were generally reduced before the close.

The gain of \$227,000,000 in federal reserve brokers' loans, announced last night, had a chilling effect upon speculative sentiment for the moment.

Case threshing was a buoyant feature of the market, jumping 25 points to a record price at 250. Eastman Kodak was again buoyant on rumors of a split-up, and reached a new record above 200, being more than 8 points.

Auto's Auto, however, sold off 10 points, and General Electric and Dupont each 4.

Transactions were generally light owing to the absence from town of many traders. Total sales approximated 1,250,000 shares. The market closed fairly steady.
