

BERRIES SCARCE PORTLAND MART

PORTLAND, Ore., July 9.—(AP) There was a spread of 40 cents between the poorest and the best strawberries at the East Side market today, with the fruit scarce even at those figures. The tail end of the season is not far off. Blackcaps are beginning to arrive in larger quantities, although the price holds firm. Producers sold at the following prices: Strawberries, \$1.80 to \$2; blackcaps, \$2; loganberries, \$1.25; raspberries, \$1.75 to \$2; peaches, 3 1/2 to 5 cents pound; beans, 9 to 10 cents; new spuds, 3 cents; carrots, 25 cents dozen bunches; beets, 25 cents dozen bunches; turnips, 50 to 65 cents dozen bunches; celery, 40 cents to \$1 dozen bunches; cauliflower, \$1 crate; spinach, 50 cents box.

In the absence of official quotations, which were formerly fixed by the Portland Dairy Exchange, the price of butter is in a somewhat uncertain state. The majority of creameries were quoting standards at 44 1/2. Egg prices remain unchanged. The quality is said to show deterioration due to the warm weather and producers are being advised to keep their stock in cool places. Poultry and country dressed meats were steady.

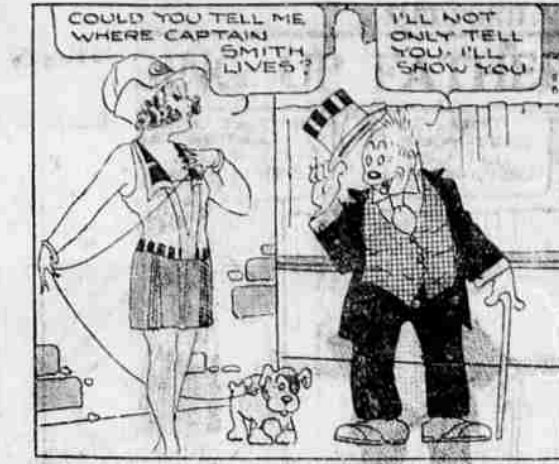
