REFRIGERATOR FUMES BLAMED FOR 3 DEATHS

CHICAGO, July 17.—(U. P.)—Lethal gas escaping from a mechanical refrigerating system yesterday was blamed by health authorities for the deaths of three persons found asphyxiated in their apartment. The condition of the bodies and a leak in the building's refrigerating system indicated that methyl chloride gas, used as a refrigerant, was responsible for the deaths.
