

REJECT BIDS ON PORT BUILDING; EXCEED BUDGET

At a special meeting of the city council this morning all bids for roofing material, carpenter work and material, wiring and painting for the Medford municipal airport building were rejected because all were in excess of the funds available for the work. The bids were opened yesterday.

The excuse the contractors gave for their bids having exceeded the unofficial estimate they had given Architect Clark is that the specifications were so indefinite they could not make their bids any lower than those submitted.

To make the situation more embarrassing to the city administration, in view of the anxiety to get the buildings at the airport started and finished as soon as possible, is that Architect Clark went to Portland the other day to attend a meeting of the state board of architects of which he is a member, and will not return until Sunday.
