

Turkish Prince Teaches Music

BUDAPEST (AP)—There are few so splendid as Prince Abdul Kadir of Turkey, son of the late Sultan Abdul Hamid, is making a name for himself here as one of the virtuosi in an Hungarian gypsy orchestra. He receives \$2.00 a night for playing in a cafe and on this brilliant night, he supported six of his children and the fact of his seven wives, as well as his attempt to one of his former mistresses.

He has tried his hand at engineering and has peddled, among other things, a military book which he said he would dedicate to the man who shall restore the Turkish monarchy. He has also composed two operettas, four dances and a farcical and has attempted, just in the form of half a dozen, to do it.

But there is no marked here for the prince. He has found Hungary gayer with gypsy music and folk songs and with no demand for musical artistic forms or symphonies of the Tin Pan Alley school.

Sitting in a dark, dingy room on the top floor of a ramshackle tenement in the Ghetto of Budapest, where he lives in company with his wife and six children, the 32-year-old prince shared with the Associated Press correspondent about the problems in which he was born and the misery to which he has come.

"I was born in a golden cradle," said the prince, his rosy face showing traces of the better privilege he has borne since Turkey expelled his father. "I was born not only with the traditional silver spoon in my mouth, but with jewels on my hands and robes on my feet. But today I have scarcely a good case my head, and am glad when I can earn enough as a musician to buy bread for my wife and children."

Abdul Kadir had spoken when he had from Turkey, but three years of extravagant living, brought him to the edge of the abyss. He six wives deserted him. The prince, from France, a Hungarian and a girl whom the prince married at the age of 17, deserted him and later obtained a judgment for alimony for herself and her baby. Four other ran away with Hungarians. His five wife, Matruh, whom he wedded in 1910, and his children, had to Smyrna and will soon marry a wealthy Turkish merchant here. The prince's present wife, Princess Mustafa, who is 18 and ravishingly beautiful, threatens to leave him and take her six-month-old baby with her.

But the bitter fate which has befallen him, suggested Abdul Kadir has abandoned him to extreme fresh poverty. Only recently, a faithful negro servant who attended the prince from childhood, drowned himself in the Danube when he learned that his royal master could no longer support him. His brother, Prince Abdul Rahim Effendi, is in a French lunatic asylum. His niece was killed in an accident at Nice and his cousins, some of the late Sultan Mohammed V, are living in misery in Syria.

Abdul Kadir is bearing these slings and arrows of outraged fortune with stoic resignation. This is due, his friends say, to the prince's Oriental training in fatalism. It is all "kismet."

When the Roosevelt was disassembled after the run, the engine and driving mechanism were found capable of giving an indefinite period of further satisfactory service.

"It is significant that the record-breaking Roosevelt was a stock car in every mechanical detail picked at random in the Marmon factory by American Automobile Association representatives. It was a sedan model, not a stripped roadster.

"Marmon was among the first to build straight-eight automobiles as a class and he has in the straight-eight principle has been amply justified by the 448-hour non-stop endurance record of the Roosevelt."
