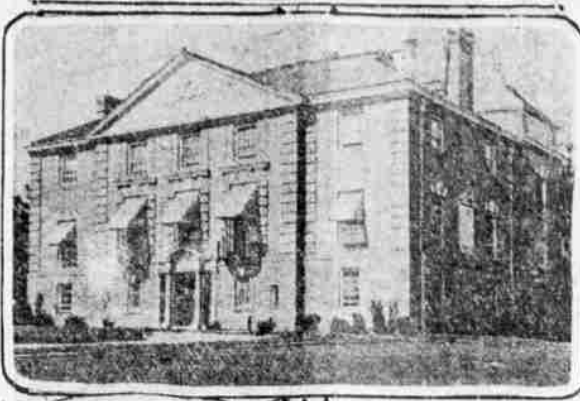

Farm Pointers

(By U. S. Department of Agriculture)

Most cows need a rest of from four to six weeks between lactation periods.

Cucumbers for market should not be cleaned with a cloth or brush, as this destroys the small spines and the "frosty" finish of fresh cucumbers.

Special care should be taken at this time of year with milk and cream that is shipped from the farm.

The summer silo usually is the best means of supplementing dried-up pastures in July and August.

During the summer the dipping method may be used effectively against the more than 40 species of lice that infest various domestic fowls.

Fields of hay consisting mostly of weeds can be put in the silo since the plants that aren't eaten in the green state or as hay usually are eaten as silage.

The safest manner of disposing of carcasses of animals on the farm is to burn them to ashes; the next safest may be to cover them with lime and bury them deeply.

Potato growers in the lower Rio Grande valley of Texas are increasing their production about 10 per cent through use of mechanical diggers.
