'NEW VOICKESE' GETS SANCTION OF UNIVERSITY

One-Time Vulgar Pronunciation of East Side Is Respectable, Say Savants

Sounding of 'R' Is Scotch-Irish Trait.

NEW YORK, July 29.—(AP)—A badge of scholarly and official respectability has been given to the pronunciation of first as "foist" or of New York as "New Yoick."

This educational change of heart was contained in an announcement from the American council of learned societies at Columbia university of plans for making a dialect atlas of the United States.

In the announcement, Prof. Hans Kurath of Ohio State university, was quoted as saying:

"Movements of population have tremendous importance in the shaping and spread of dialect. The New York 'oi' to which the East Side may claim 'foist' rights, has been carried to all parts of the city, to Long Island, to New Jersey and up the Hudson, by business men and working men, and commuters have imported it into Connecticut towns along the sound."

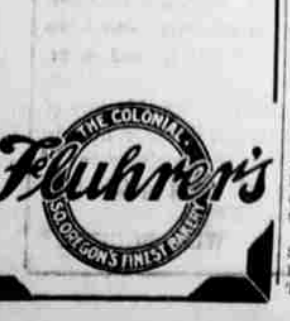
This one-time vulgar pronunciation is fast becoming respectable with the rise of the speaker to commercial, political and cultural importance. Not a few professors at Columbia university are using it in a somewhat milder form, and ex-governor Alfred E. Smith is not the only man of prominence to use it socially.

Kurath credited the widespread use of all his 'R's' in part to the persistence of our Scotch-Irish. He traced it back to the Scotch-Irish from Scotland and northern England who in their new American homes continued all their 'R's.'

For years it has been devoted to compiling the dialect atlas. It aims to embrace ultimately the English dialects in all North America, and the foreign language colonies such as Pennsylvania Dutch, Canadian and Louisiana French, Spanish in the southwest and Scandinavian in Minnesota and the Dakotas.
