Wall Street Report

New York, July 29.—(AP) A sweeping reaction in stock prices took place in today's market after several ineffective attempts had been made to rally the general list by marking up special stocks. While intermittent selling had been going on throughout the morning, the liquidating movement did not gather full force until around midday when a storm of selling orders suddenly appeared, and carried scores of issues 2 to 12 points below last week's final quotations. A vigorous bull demonstration on Eastman Kodak and Radio which rose 4 and 2 points, failed to bolster the market in the last hour. Utilities continued to drift lower, losses of 5 to 7 1/2 points occurring in Pacific Telephone, Western Union, Detroit Edison, North American, Consolidated Gas and Standard Gas "A" and Electric. The closing tone was weak. Total sales approximated 3,200,000 shares.
