

PRICE UNCHANGED ON WATERMELONS

PORTLAND, Ore., Aug. 12.—Receipt of the yellow meat watermelons from the Medford area was reported today. They were being sold at 4 cents a pound. Watermelons were still unchanged in price. Oregon melons from the Hamilton district were due next week, when prices were expected to weaken. Butter and egg prices were unchanged. The newly organized Portland Produce Exchange held its first session today, but found nothing to warrant any disturbance in prices. Only the butter situation was discussed. Blueberries dropped to \$1.15 per bushel, green corn to \$1.25, cucumbers to 50 cents a box, celery to 75 cents a dozen bunches and squash to 65¢ a box. Tomatoes were slightly higher at 75 cents, lettuce at \$1.25, and celery hearts at \$1.50. There was an unusually brisk demand for lettuce. Trading was active and other prices held steady.

CLOVER GROWERS IN MARKET POOL

GRANTS PASS, Ore., Aug. 12.—G. L. O'Neil of Josephine county was named chairman of a committee on organization at a meeting of Idaho clover growers here last night in a preliminary move toward organizing a pool for marketing hay and certified seed. The group representing more than 100 acres under cultivation advanced funds for the purchase of a clover huller designed to safeguard seed for sowing purposes.

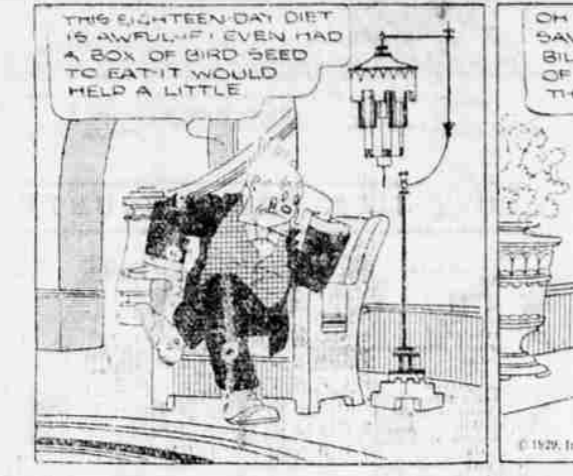
