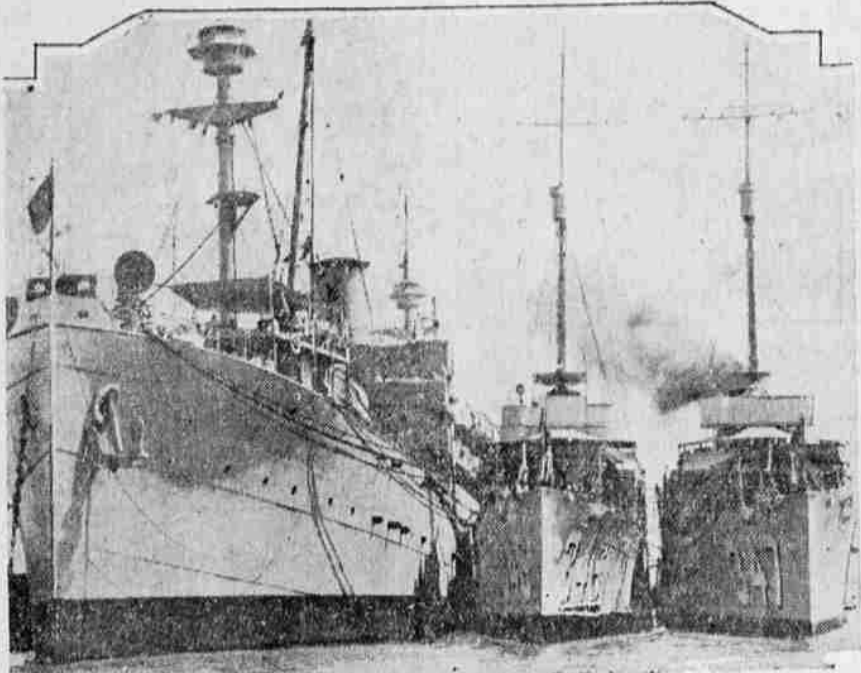
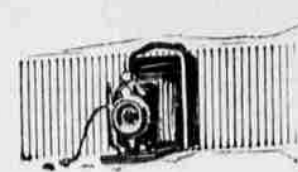

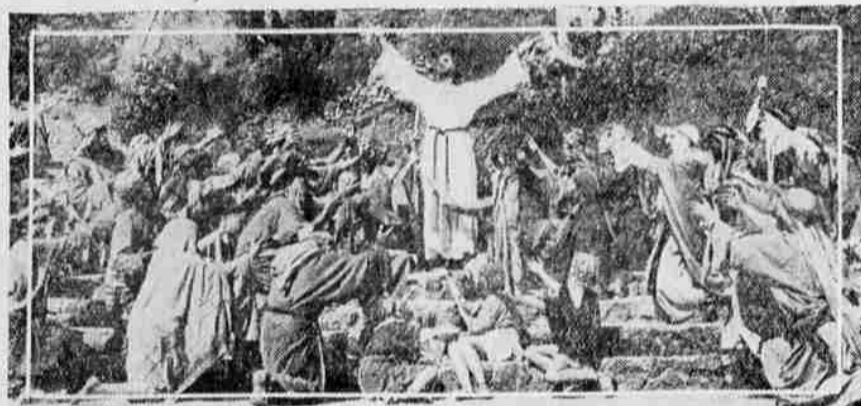
BEST DRESSED member of President Hoover's new farm cabinet which is hopeful of solving the farmers' ills is said to be James C. Stone of Kentucky.



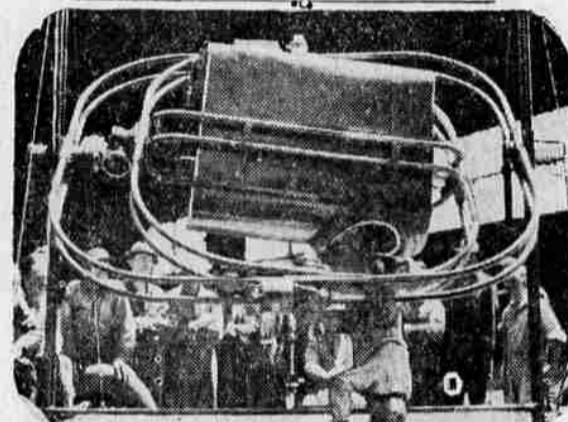
A BRILLIANT SCREEN CAREER for Ruth Elder, pretty aviatrix-actress, is predicted by critics. This is one of her latest pictures.



WELL—WELL—WELL! It's Doris Hill's methods of evading misery from the warm weather. And this young movie actress wears a hot outfit to do her hot stepping.



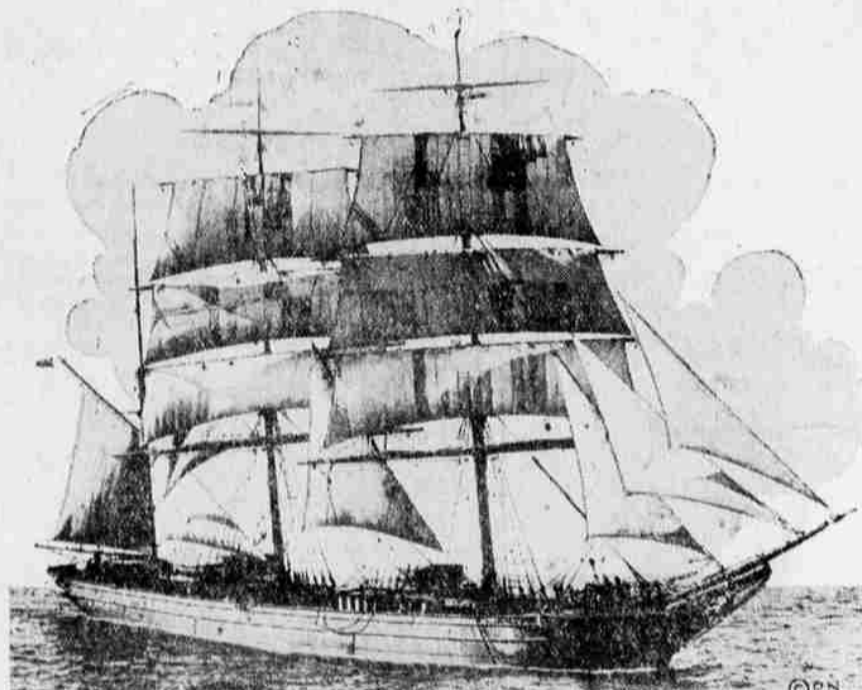

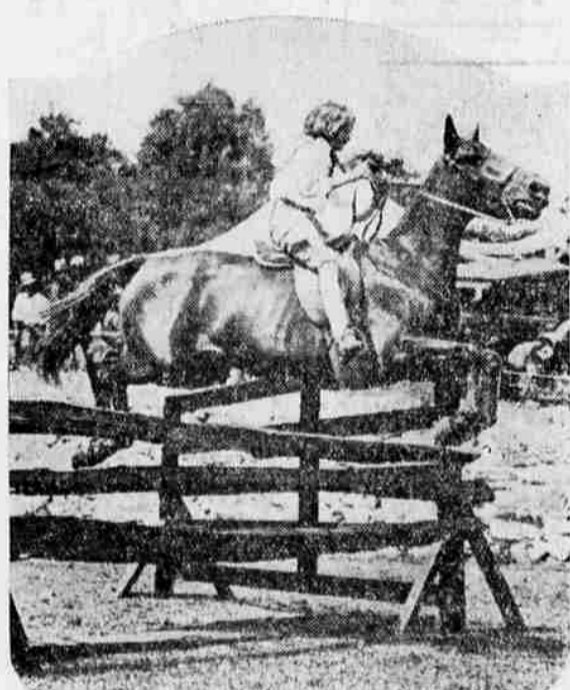

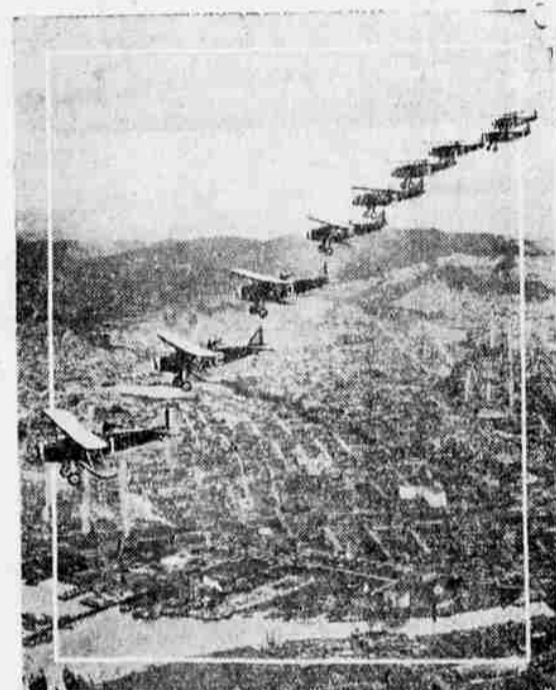

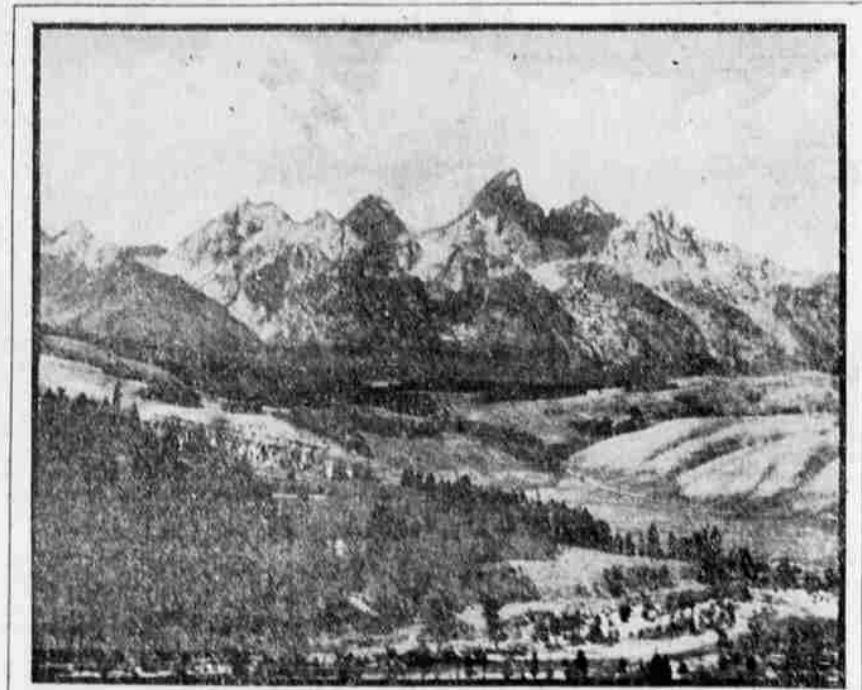
