

CHRISTIAN SCIENCE 50TH ANNIVERSARY

BOSTON, Aug. 23.—The Christian Science celebration throughout the world today observed the 50th anniversary of the organization here by Mrs. Mary Baker Eddy and a group of six of her students of the First Church of Christ, Scientist.

For some time previous to the granting of the Massachusetts charter, which founded the Mother Church, Mrs. Eddy and her students had been meeting in homes of members as the Christian Science Association. Meetings continued to be held in homes and later in halls until in 1892 a reorganization was effected and what is now the mother church, the First Church of Christ, Scientist, was founded and to it, Mrs. Eddy, the first pastor of the new denomination, gave the plot of ground in Huntington Avenue on which was erected the original Mother Church office.

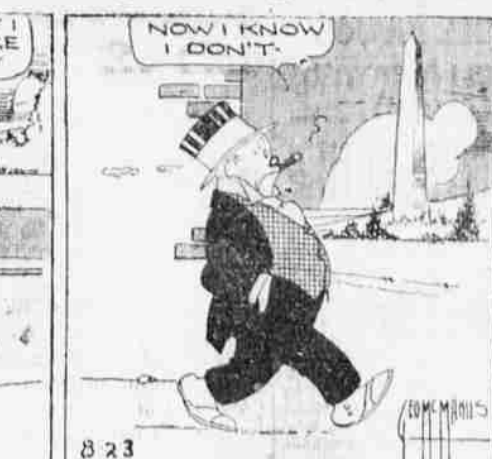
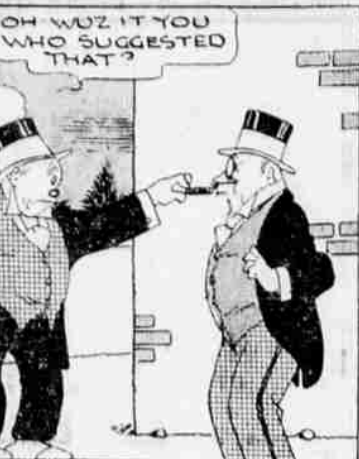
