

SHORT RECEIPTS  
FORCING BUTTER  
TO HIGHER PRICE

PORTLAND, Ore., Aug. 24.—(AP)—Short receipts of butter has transformed the market into a buoyant affair. Portland quotations had been at an even keel for some days, but advance in the San Francisco market has forced an upward swing here. All grades were advanced one cent today with extras at 47, standards at 46, prime firsts at 45 and firsts at 42. At the same time creameries tacked on a recent advance on the Portland delivery price of butterfat, making it 50 cents. The station and track quotations were not disturbed. Eggs were firm and flitting with higher values. Poultry and dressed meats were steady.
