BRITON PATIENCE IS WEARING THIN ON REPARATIONS

THE HAGUE, Aug. 24.—(AP)—Philip Snowden, British chancellor of the exchequer, and storm center of The Hague reparations conference, again moved into the forefront of the deliberations today with a letter to Henri Daffer, Belgian premier, in which he declared the British delegation had exercised nearly all the patience of its command in discussing Britain's demands for a large share of Young plan payments with her four wartime allies.
