

**OWEN-OREGON WILL  
CLOSE NIGHT SHIFT**

Effective Saturday, September 14, the night shift of the Owen-Oregon Lumber company will be discontinued. Orders to this effect were issued yesterday. It affects 175 workers, and means the closing down of an Owen-Oregon logging camp in the Bitter Falls district and a dozen small logging

gangs, operating in the Trout, Jacksonville, Gold Hill, Evans Creek and Jacksonville districts. No reason was given for the action, except the usual one, "unsettled condition of the lumber market."

**DOUKHOBORS IN  
PRISON COLONY  
IS SUGGESTION**

Defiance of School Laws and Practice of Nude Parades Wearing Patience of Dominion Officials—Island Chosen.

VICTORIA, B. C., Sept. 12.—(AP) Segregation of fanatical Doukhobors by the Dominion government in an island prison colony has been suggested by the authorities of British Columbia.

Disturbances arising from the practice of the Doukhobors of holding nude parades and their defiance of school laws have resulted in nearly 200 of them being jailed and a number of their children being committed to public institutions. The plan for a prison colony on Darcy Island in Georgia Bay has been placed before Dr. J. H. King, Dominion minister of health, by provincial authorities who contend that the disposition of fanatical groups among the sect is a Dominion problem. The Doukhobors were brought into the provinces of British Columbia, Saskatchewan and Alberta by the Ottawa government under contract. Some of the officials pointed out could deal with the situation adequately. Darcy Island was suggested as the site for such a colony because escape is almost impossible.
