Mr. Carkin will return here in a few days and remain to close up city attorney affairs, preparatory to turning over the city attorney's office, which he had held for the past 10 years, to his recently appointed successor, Frank P. Farrell, whom he will continue to assist in getting thoroughly acquainted in the important matters of the city government until October 1, after which date Mr. Farrell will be in complete charge of the office, and Mr. Carkin will leave for Salem, where he will give his entire time thereafter to his duties as a member of the state tax board.

The leaving of Medford by the Carkins family is much regretted by a wide circle of friends and acquaintances, as while Mr. Carkin has been conspicuous in public affairs for many years, Mrs. Carkin has taken a prominent part in educational and women's club matters.

COAL MINE FATALITIES REPORTED INCREASING

SALEM, Sept. 18.—(AP) The seriousness of the St. Charles coal mine disaster, reported three days ago, is growing hourly, with a death list of 23 and 25 injured.

After three days continuous fighting against the underground fire, the blaze continues with undiminished seriousness and tremors occasionally felt indicate further explosions have occurred in the depths of the subterranean galleries, which it is impossible to enter to recover bodies of the victims.

CHIEF FEDERAL HORTICULTURIST VISITS STATION

Dr. E. C. Auchter, chief horticulturist of the Department of Agriculture, spent yesterday in the city and valley on a hurried survey of local fruit conditions. He left last night for San Francisco.

Dr. Auchter spent the forenoon at the Southern Oregon Experiment station at Talent, with Prof. E. C. Reimer, and in the afternoon visited the packing plants and orchards.

Dr. Auchter has charge of all fruit investigations with the highly trained specialists under his command. The Pacific Northwest, now under way for Bartlett shipments from this valley are under his supervision. He expects to pay a longer visit to this section next spring, to gather orchard heating and other data.

Dr. Auchter expressed himself as highly satisfied with the work of the Southern Oregon Experiment station, under the direction of Prof. Reimer, and also commended the co-operation of the Fruitgrowers League and the Rogue River Traffic association with the experiment station work. He said the cooperation had come under his notice in reports from this valley.

LABOR COUNCIL GRANTS MORE LOCAL CHARTERS

At a meeting of the Medford Labor Council last night formation of local unions for barbers, motion picture operators and butchers was reported. Charters for these three organizations were granted. The meeting was addressed by Ben Osborne, member of the State Federation of Labor.

Oregon Has Thirteen Million Acres of Public Lands Which Would Come Under Plan for Transfer to State

WASHINGTON, Sept. 18.—If President Hoover's plan for transferring public lands to the states meets the approval of the commission he will appoint and find favor in congress, 190,000,000 acres of land will be placed in the hands of the states.

The greater portion of the area is in states west of the eastern Colorado and Wyoming border. Nevada, where 55,410,000 acres or 71 per cent of the entire state is in public domain, will be most greatly affected.

Utah, with 25,147,867 acres of its area in public domain, is the second largest public land state in the union. California, with 26,369,421 acres, ranks third.

The income from the public lands of the country last year was \$5,195,565, which includes money received for the sale of land. Of this amount 10 per cent went into the general fund of the federal treasury, 52 per cent to the reclamation fund, all of which is spent in western or public land states, and 37 per cent went back into public land states for schools and roads.

WASHINGTON, Sept. 18.—(AP) Senate Republicans were called to get together today for a party conference on the tariff as a showdown approaches on the first of the many controversial items in this controversial bill.

Senator Watson of Indiana, the Republican leader, called the party gathering with a view to sounding out his strength in the approaching contest and with an eye to lining up his forces for the more immediate issue—the flexible provisions of the tariff act.

Two splinters in the Republican ranks this week on the tariff are giving some concern to the majority leaders. The Republican independent group, headed by Senator Borah of Idaho, and Norris of Nebraska, has been counted out of the party fold for some time, so far as any votes on the tariff bill are concerned. Now the new split involving senators from the far northwestern states is giving worry.

In order to hold a majority against a combination of Democrats and the Republican independents, the Republican regulars cannot afford to lose the support of the far northwestern group, including Senators Jones of Washington, McNary and Stewart of Oregon, and Johnson of California.
