

NOTED ARTIST IS VICTIM OF NIGHT CALLER

Frank Reed Whiteside Slain
On Own Doorstep in
Philadelphia—Robbery Is
Possible Motive—Neigh-
bors Hear Fatal Shot.

PHILADELPHIA, Sept. 20.—(AP)—Frank Reed Whiteside, 63, a landscape artist of note, was slain by a mysterious gunman last night as he answered the doorbell of his quaint old two-story home in Waverly street. He was shot thru the heart, dying almost instantly. The bullet which ended his life was found lodged in the door jam in the vestibule.

Robbery was given by the police today as a possible motive for the shooting. The artist's pockets were found turned inside out. His gold watch and chain, however, had not been taken from his pocket.

Women neighbors who heard the shot and found Whiteside's body slumped across the doorway, told police they had seen a shabbily-dressed youth run down the quiet, tree-lined residential street in the heart of the city a moment after the shooting.

Mr. Whiteside, who was treasurer of the Pennsylvania academy of the fine arts, an instructor and author, was alone in his home. His wife, who is convalescing from recent illness, and his daughter, with whom he had spent the summer at Ogunquit, Maine, were expected home in a few days.

The aged artist had attended a dinner of the Sketch club last night and apparently had been reading after returning to his home, for an open book was found on the arm of a chair under a reading lamp in his living room. Nothing had been disturbed in the home.

Mrs. Julia Blankenburg, who lives next door, told the authorities she had heard Whiteside's doorbell ring twice and then heard him open the door.

"Almost immediately afterward," she said, "there was a shot. I ran to my front door and saw Mr. Whiteside lying on his steps. His head and part of his body were inside the vestibule and his legs were sprawled out on the steps."

BORDER PATROL REPULSES GANG BOOZE RUNNERS

EL PASO, Texas, Sept. 20.—(AP)—More than 300 rounds of ammunition were fired by United States border patrolmen last night in two fights with a band of Mexican rum runners attempting to land a cargo of liquor on American soil.

Both fights took place on Cordova Island near here. The rum runners were repulsed. Three Mexicans, two of them 14 year old "spotters," were arrested, and two of the smugglers, apparently wounded, were seen crawling into the brush on the Mexican side.

The smuggling band numbered more than thirty men, officers estimated. They returned the fire of the border patrolmen bravely, but none of the officers was wounded. More than 50 gallons of liquor was confiscated.

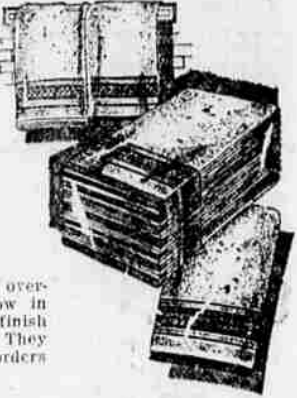
