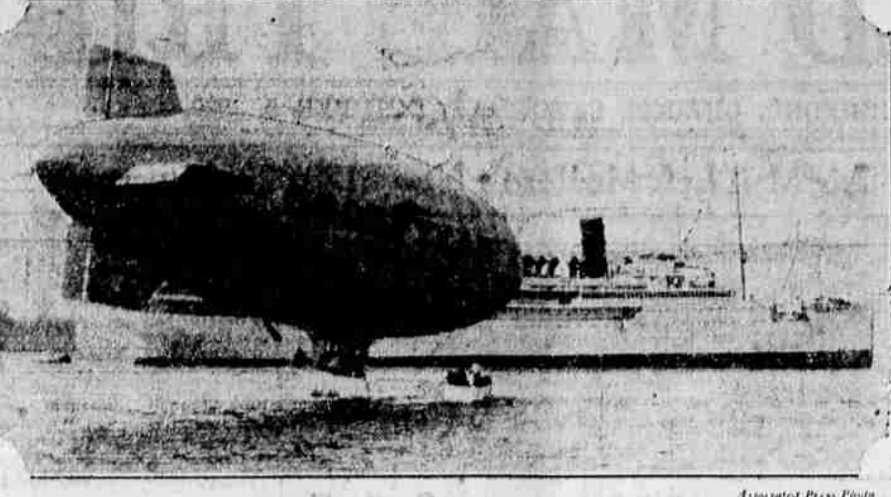


Local and Personal
