

REESE CREEK HUNTER BAGS 4-POINT BUCK

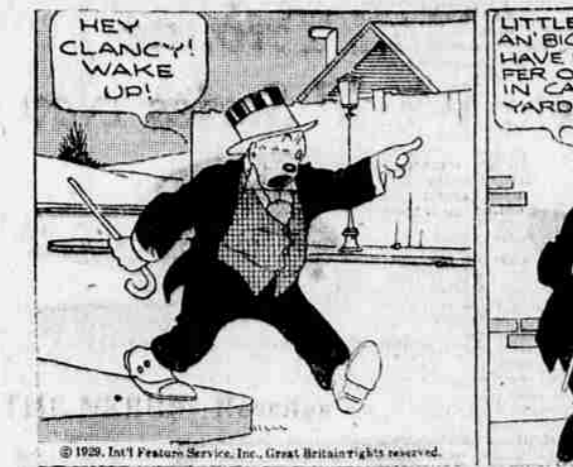

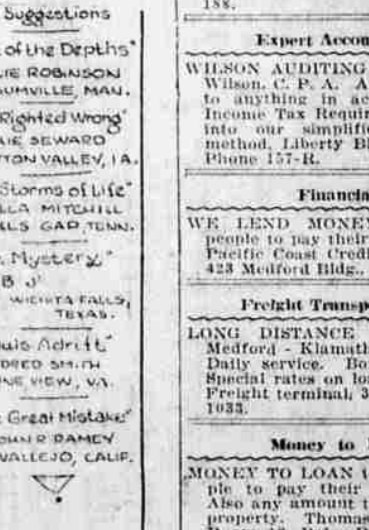
