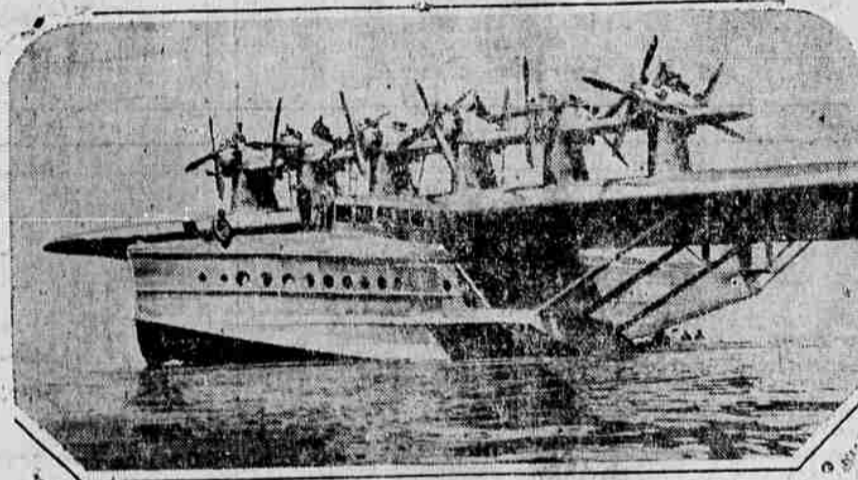

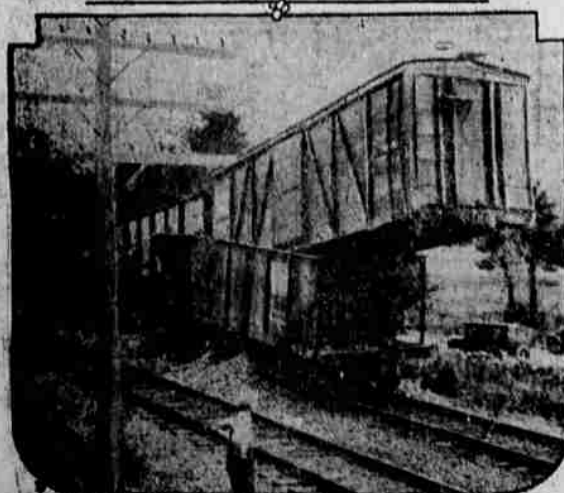

HIS HOLINESS, POPE PIUS XI, is shown above at work in his study at the Vatican in Rome. This is a new and excellent study of the pope.



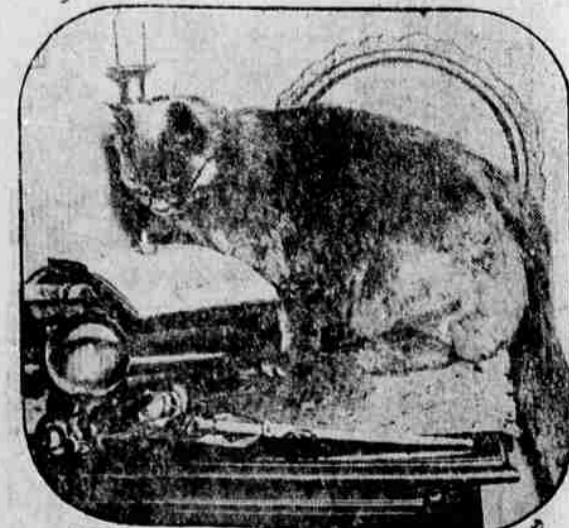
