

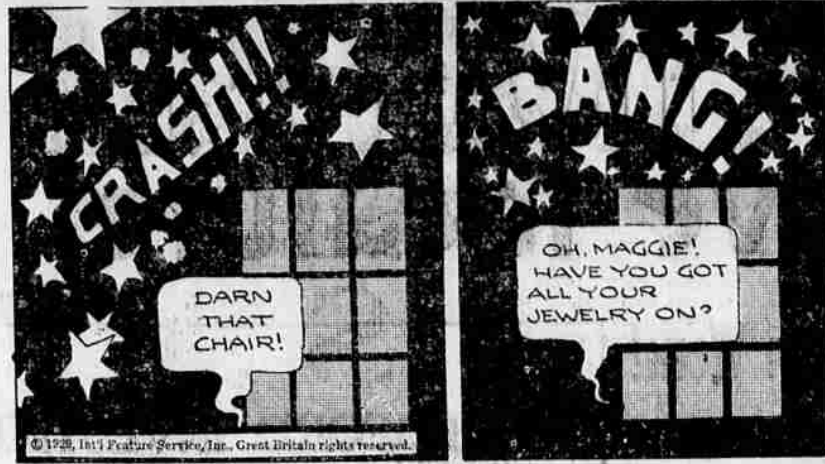
EAGLE POINT PTA MEET SCHEDULED FOR NEXT FRIDAY

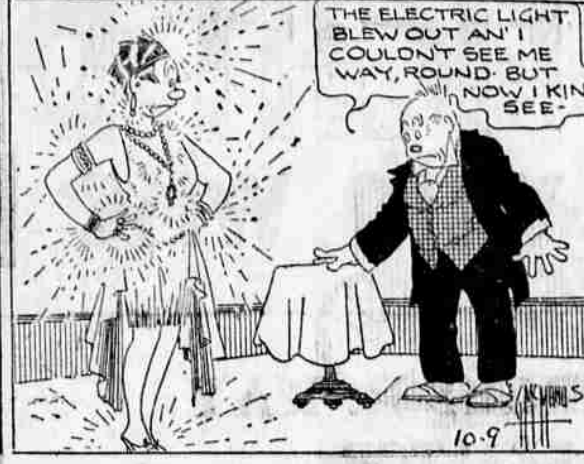
