

OVER SUPPLY OF COUNTRY MEATS

PORTLAND, Ore., Oct. 17.—(AP) Because of an oversupply, choice veal and lamb have taken another big price cut, according to a leading product company.

Poultry prices are also easier, not so much because of an oversupply, but because other points are preventing shipments from here by underselling Portland.

Butter prices were steady and egg values firm, without indication of further decrease or increase.

Reviewing the fruit and vegetable situation, the Portland market news service of the United States Department of Agriculture says:

"Bartlett pears were nearly all cleaned up. The current market was mostly supplied with D'Anjou and Comice at \$3 and \$3.25 per box for extra heavy stock.
