

PULLET EGGS TAKE ADVANCE PORTLAND

PORTLAND, Ore., Oct. 22.—(AP)—Pullet eggs, which advanced from 30 to 32 cents to retailers, and from 28 to 30 to wholesalers, the prices of eggs remained firm and unchanged today.

Butter was also firm and unchanged. Trading at the East Side market of the Gardeners' and Ranchers' association was moderate with the bulk of the sales in such seasonal products as cauliflower, celery, lettuce, apples, grapes, potatoes, carrots, spinach, onions, cabbage and the like. Prices for the most part very little from day to day.

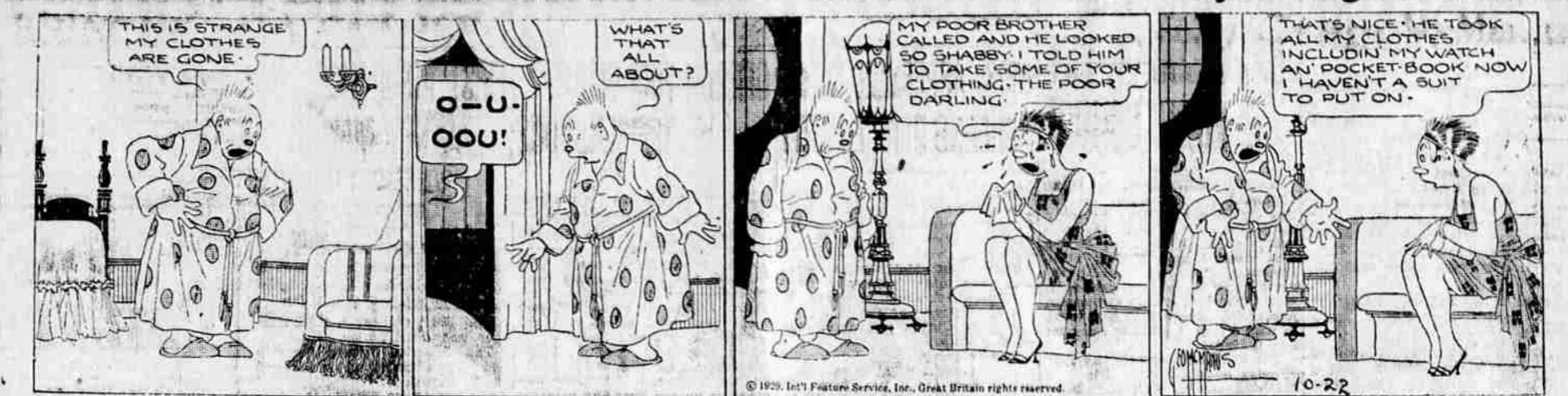
