MIDWAY DISTRICT WATER LINE BIDS WILL BE STUDIED

At a meeting of the board of directors of the Midway Water district held last night at the Howard school, bids for the furnishing and installation of water pipe were opened but no award will be made until after a joint meeting with the city water commission, when the bids and plans will be studied. No date has been set for the joint session, but it will be held within the week.

Two bids were filed. They were the Hillsboro Power company for furnishing of steel pipe, and R. I. Stewart and Sons of this city, for the furnishing of cast-iron pipe. No figures were made public.

The bids call for the laying of the water pipe to the property line of homes within the district, which extends from the north city limits to the Lee Merriman place on the Pacific highway.

At the meeting last night members of the board, and a few interested property owners were in attendance.

EMPTY ROOMS BECKON AID FOR AGED WOMAN

Wandering alone through the busy afternoon crowd of shoppers, Mrs. E. P. Reid, lame and past 80 years of age, carried a heavy armload of packages home with her today. The load wouldn't have seemed so heavy, she confided to a sympathetic listener with whom she struck up a conversation, had she not had the burden of earning her own livelihood also upon her shoulders.

Three rooms she has to rent, at her address, 137 Tripp street. At present they are vacant, and her life, as a consequence, echoes their condition. The rooms, she declares, are nicely furnished—three of them, and a sleeping porch. She knows that if she were not lame, and could get out and "rustle around" like some of the younger folks, she would have them occupied in no time. As it is, she prays every night that some nice person will come along and choose her place as a lodging. And somehow she knows they will—some day.

PAT PLANES AVERAGE 108 MILES PER HOUR

Air mail and passengers on the Pacific Air Transport planes were down at an average speed of 108 miles an hour between Los Angeles, Medford, Seattle and intermediate points during the past month, company officials announced today.

This is substantially faster than any time in the history of Pacific coast air mail service. Pilot J. Russell Cunningham set a record for pilots on the coast run with an average cruising speed of 129 miles with a Boeing mail four-passenger plane which has a 525 h. p. Hornet engine, which is now standard installation on Pacific Air Transport ships.

As a farewell shot to the old quarters Mr. Hutchinson put up an especially fine brand of weather today. From today on all mail for the weather bureau will be received at the new quarters, and all telephone communication will be with it there. The weather station retains its old number, 612.
