

PLANE ENGINE OF 21 PARTS TESTED BY TEXAS PILOTS

HOLSTON, Tex. (AP)—An airplane engine of only 21 working parts—about one-tenth as many as in an ordinary engine—has been built and tested in flight by two Houston inventors.

The engine, called the "Hurricane," its backers say, approaches the ultimate in simplicity of construction. It weighs 225 pounds, develops 150 horsepower and requires an average of seven gallons of gasoline an hour. Its designers, H. E. Lyons and Victor T. Toce, say it can be built more cheaply than engines now in general use.

Lyons and Toce have completed the engine after eight years of work. It operates on the two-cycle principle and has neither valves, rocker arms nor carburetor. It is a six-cylinder radial type.

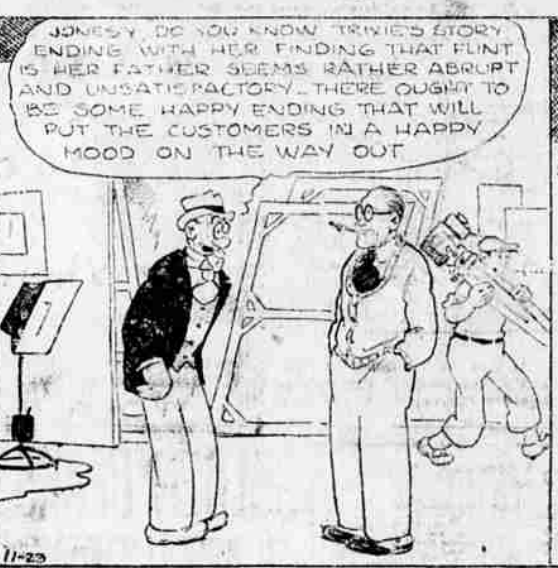

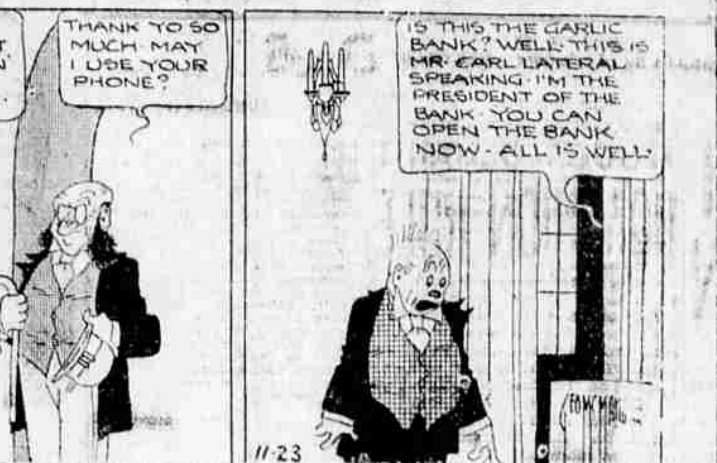
