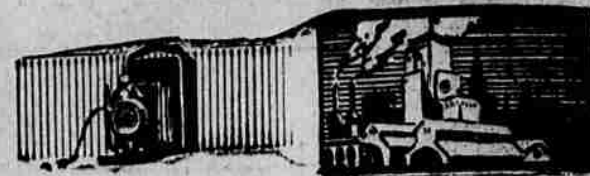


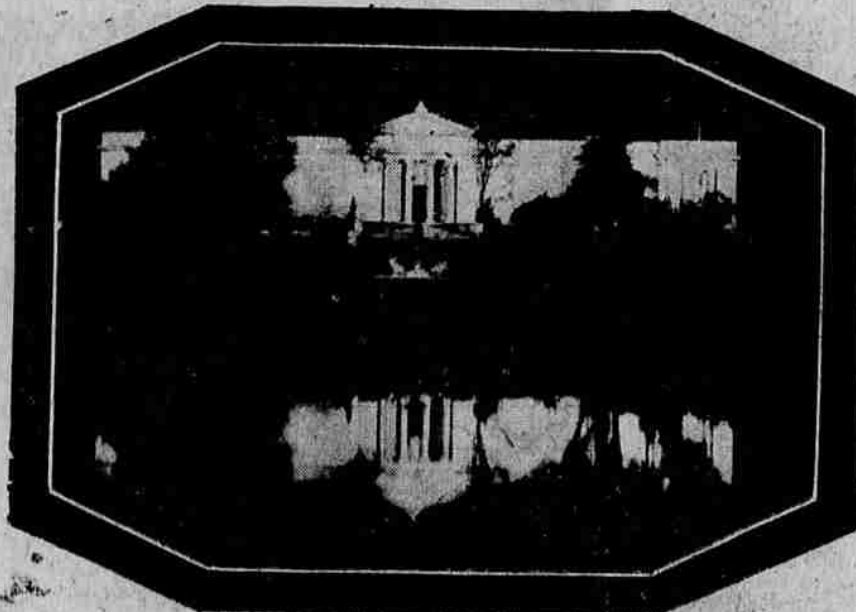

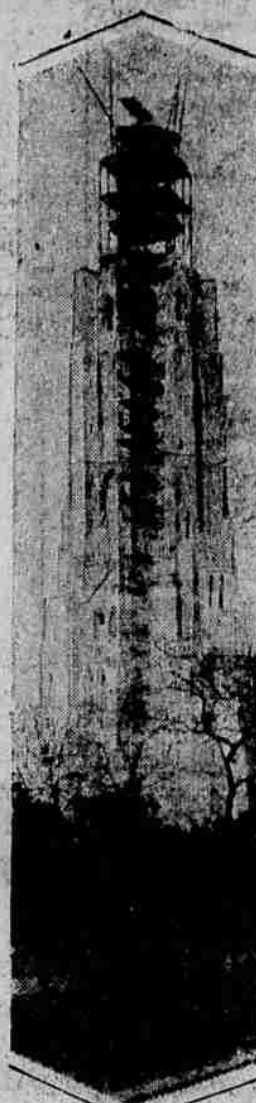

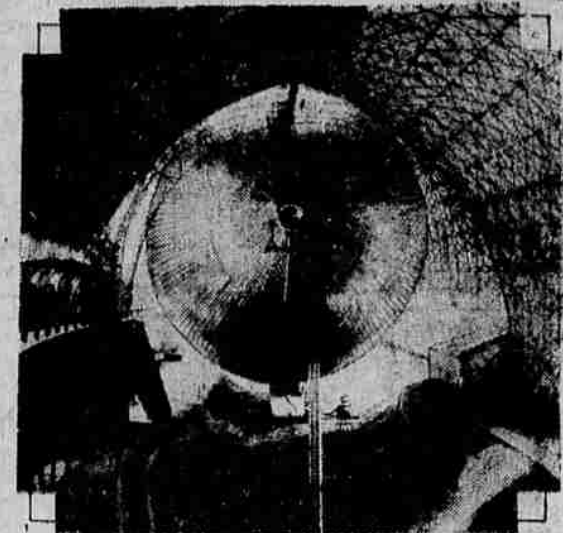

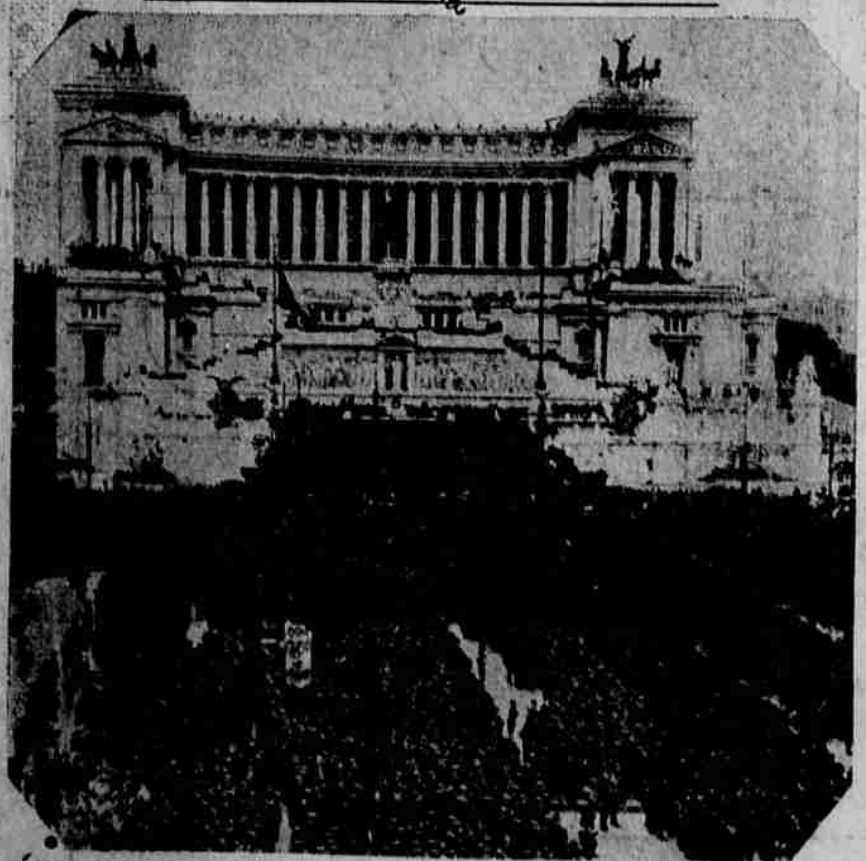
CHARMING, indeed, does Dolores Costello appear in this camera study. She's one of America's most popular screen actresses.

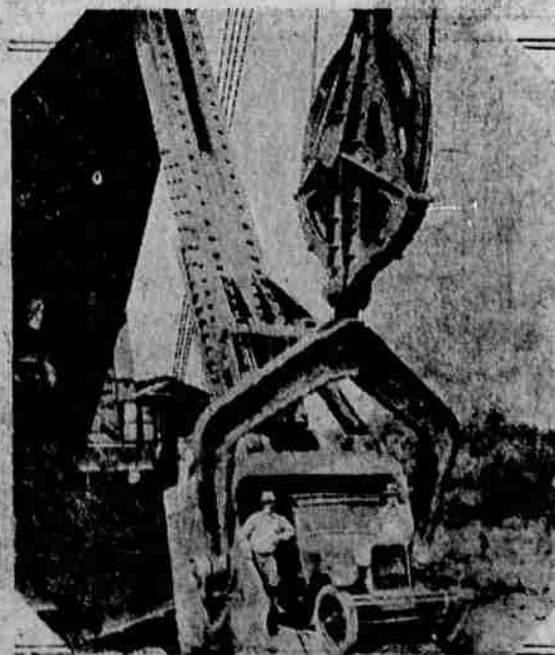
