

PITTSBURG FOE FOR TROJANS IN NEW YEAR TILT

LOS ANGELES, Cal., Dec. 5.—(AP)—The University of Southern California announced today that the University of Pittsburgh has accepted its invitation to play the New Year's day game in the Pasadena rose bowl.

Pittsburgh's acceptance will bring to the rose bowl one of the most powerful gridiron machines of the country which has weathered its season without defeat or tie. Southern California, ranked as one of the west's greatest teams, has met defeat twice overwhelmingly by the University and by one point at the hands of Notre Dame.

CHRISTMAS CARDS BY THOUSANDS GO IN WASTE YEARLY

Owing to the fact that millions of Christmas cards find their way to the dead letter office of the postoffice department at Washington at holiday time every year and are then destroyed, and the fact that Christmas senders from Medford and other parts of Jackson county no doubt contribute their share to this situation, Postmaster Wm. J. Warner issues a special warning for all senders of Christmas cards, letters, etc., to put their names and return addresses on each letter, card or parcel sent out by them to an out-of-town address.

Most people, especially at Christmas time, neglect this, principally due to the fact that so many of them only contact with distant friends once a year, and take it for granted that their friends are living at the same location and address as when they last heard from them, whereas they may have moved to another town or different address entirely.

Not one in a thousand people sign their full names and addresses in writing cards or letters, merely signing such missives with a first name—such as Bill, Mary and Bob, or Ed and Family, and the like, and very few people at any time place a return address and name on the face of the card or envelope. Hence the millions of such missives accumulating annually at the dead letter office, especially at Christmas time for the postoffice department, although famed for accomplishing wonders in seeing that every misdirected or inelegibly written card reaches the one to whom it is sent, is not a mind-reading or miracle factory.

For instance, suppose a Medford patron sent a Christmas card signed merely "Bob and Sue," "Bill," "Ed and Family," to friends or relatives at a distant point, from which unknown to the sender they have moved to another city or town, or died, how can the postoffice officials or the dead letter department figure out who Bob and Sue or Ed, are, and where they live? Such a missive is not worth wasting any time on, and therefore after being held at the dead letter office a reasonable time, is checked into the dead letter office furnace.

The sender of the card wonders what is the matter with friend or friends, or maybe relatives, to whom the card is sent. "Have they gotten uppish? All right, if they wish to ignore us, let 'em."

Hence, every one in mailing out Christmas cards or letters, or Christmas packages should have a return address and name on them. This would not only greatly expedite the general work of the postoffice department, enabling the tracing up of a lost or strayed card, letter or parcel quickly, but would insure the sender getting his missive or parcel returned, if the person to whom it had been sent had moved away or died.
