

JOSEPHINE BUDGET HIGHER BY FOURTH

GRANTS PASS, Ore.—(AP)—Although it will not be finally accepted by the county commissioners before January 1, 1930, the proposed county budget, one-fourth higher than a year ago, apparently has rough sledding ahead. A fight against the acceptance of the proposed budget as presented to the county commissioners will not center around the proposed increase in expenses, but will hinge upon whether the municipal airport will receive official aid from Josephine county, it is said.

The airport was sponsored by the American Legion. The fact that the present proposed budget does not contain any fund which might be used to maintain the field, indicates, the legion believes, that the county expects the airport to be kept by citizens through popular subscription.

A report that oil may be found on the site is said to have led to an expression by officials that a lease to an oil company, in event oil is struck, would mean more Josephine county than an airport.
