

Half Million **Dollars Spent** on Homes in Medford, 1929

More fine residences, ranging in price from \$10,000 to \$50,000 were built in Medford during 1929 than any previous year in the city's history. Here are nine of the more expensive homes out of over a hundred new ones constructed.

While total building construction in Medford in 1929 was third highest the residence construction total was twice what it had ever been before. The cost of new residences alone amounted to approximate 1/2 ya500,000, and adding cost of real estate, new furnishings and landscape gardening the total approximated half a million.
