Medford Club Seats New Officers At Banquet Meet - Rev. Porter Appointed Speaker of Evening - Committees Appointed for Year.

A banquet, a speech by Rev. Claude B. Porter and songs by Miss Margaret Arnold and James Stevens were featured last night at the annual installation of officers of the Medford Kiwanis club at the Hotel Medford.

In the main address of the evening, Rev. Claude B. Porter touched upon moral issues of present day living and the ability to determine right from wrong.

Self approval may be obtained in four ways, first of which is to eliminate outside disapprovers and this is often done by sending the disapprovers away and in the cases of big cities, murders are often the result.

Changing the subject to prisons and prison revolts, Rev. Porter would eliminate the words "prison" and "penal" from the American vocabulary and in their stead use the term of reformatory institutions.

Teaching lightly on the prohibition question, Rev. Porter declared the only way to determine whether law was going to stand the test of time and receive the undivided support of the populace is by rigid enforcement.

ROAD BUILDING SEEN AS KEY IN U. S. RELATIONS

Mexican And Central American Programs Expected To Speed Understanding - Six Countries To Spend Hundred Million.

By Lyle C. Wilson, United Press Staff Correspondent. WASHINGTON. — (U.P.)—The problem of American relations with Mexico and Central America is expected by officials to be greatly simplified by consummation of road building projects upon which reports are now being compiled in Washington.

Survey of the highway problem confronting Mexico and the smaller republics shows that the requirement to be met is adequate funds although engineering difficulties are tremendous in much of the area.

Arctic to Equator. The highway programs being developed to the south of the Rio Grande will find a link through the United States the project for a system of Canadian and Alaskan highways which would open to the automobile tourist an uninterupted pleasure route from the rim of the Arctic Circle to a point below the Equator and to the truckman an unrivaled chain of commercial routes.

KITCHEN POLICE DUTY ABSOLUTE IN FRANCE

PARIS—(U.P.)—Hereafter the French soldier will confine his efforts entirely to the manly art of fighting with no time out for "kitchen police." Innovations in the new army bill take cognizance of the limited time the one-year training law allows for learning soldiering, and all the latest mechanical devices, such as make household a pleasure instead of a drudgery, will be introduced.

According to the 1929 war bill, French mothers will no longer raise their soldiers to be gentle, men spud peelers, barrack cinderellas, kitchen scullions, and mop wielders. In the new bill household's knees will be entirely eliminated from the army, for Minister of War Maginot is going to replace all these domestic jobs, usually given as penalties, by the latest culinary and household inventions.
