

# CITY PLANNING EXPERTS VIEWS ARE SUBMITTED

Report of Jacob Crane Favored By Commission—Acquisition of Roxy Ann for Park Sought.

Written report of Jacob L. Crane Jr., city planning expert of national reputation, which recommends establishment of a civic center for Medford, adoption of a major street system, new zoning, and a park and playground program including utilization of Roxy Ann, was approved as a whole last night by members of the city planning commission in regular session.

Districts to be changed under the new zoning program will be published for a hearing at an early date. Immediate acquisition of the 300 acres of land on Roxy Ann, for which \$3600 was provided in the city budget, will be recommended to the council by the commission. The city has until May 10 to purchase the land from the government. This purchase has been recommended by the park committee of the city council and the body as a whole expected to favor the project.

A complete sketch of the civic center presented at the meeting and considered by the members of the commission. It is located around the present city park, in accordance with Mr. Crane's recommendation, bounded by Oakdale, Holly, Main and Eighth streets. It will necessitate the closing of Ivy street between Main and Eighth and establishment of a new street connecting with the Washington school site.

The sketch also includes building of an auditorium at Ivy and Oakdale; city hall at Ivy and Holly; library at Holly and Eighth streets; rounding intersection of King street at Oakdale and widening of all streets on the park site to allow parking space.

**Street Plan**  
Under the heading "Major street plan," Mr. Crane's recommendation reads: "I would suggest specifying that road widths be dedicated as follows: 'Along the state highway and the Crater Lake highway 120 feet; Jacksonville highway and the scenic drive not less than 100 feet; Bear Creek parkway not less than 150 feet from the creek bank to the other side of the right of way; all other major streets not less than 80 feet; all other streets not less than 65 feet, and along business frontage not less than 100 feet.'

Speaking of zoning, Mr. Crane writes: "For each of the little neighborhood business centers sketches should be made for street widening, and alleys and the owners advised that the property will be zoned for business only after dedications of widenings and alleys are made, and also preferably only after a restriction upon the use of the property is placed on record in the county to the effect that the design of each building shall be subject to the approval of the city planning commission."

"In general the streets on which these business districts front should be widened so that the building line will be not less than 50 to 60 feet from the center of the street, and the side streets not less than 40 feet from the center of the street, and the alleys should be not less than 20 feet wide."

The zoning commission also considered a new plat laying out Roseborough addition in Siskiyou Heights and matters pertaining to school property in the Oregon and Higher Terrace region.

**Urge Campaigns**  
Cleveland, Pittsburgh, and Chicago fruit distributors, viewing the success of the Detroit campaign, have requested that similar campaigns be staged in their cities. The Winter Pear committee, in its preliminary discussion of the 1930 marketing plans has considered the invasion of these markets, but will come to no definite decision until the situation has been closely studied.

Development of new markets for Bosc and winter pear varieties has become a paramount issue with pear growers. The forthcoming campaign will dovetail in many respects with the final report of Prof. Hartman, and his recommendations for handling fruit and placing it before the consumer in the highest state of edibility.

Cities selected for a Bosc campaign this season, will have storage and ripening facilities, and to determine this essential factor, is one of the objectives of Mr. Wood's trip east.
