Allot Columbia Fund

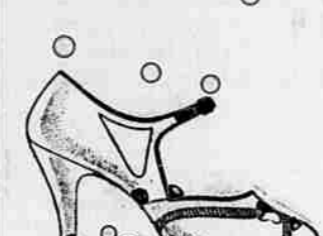
