

# OIL FLAMES PLAY HAVOC IN BAYONNE

### Explosions and Fire Follow Blast Aboard Tanker at Gulf Refinery Pier—Three Docks Destroyed As Flaming Fuel Flies.

BAYONNE, N. J., May 8.—(AP)—Fire started by an explosion in a 10,000 gallon oil tanker, today roared through the yards of the Gulf Refining company at Constable Hook, threatening the destruction of that plant and the adjacent yards of the Tidewater Oil company and the Standard Oil company.

Three men were injured, one seriously. Officials said all other employees were accounted for.
