## HUMANE SOCIETY FUND FROM CITY UP TO COMMITTEE

Subject to the final approval of the City Planning Commission, the finance committee of the city council, E. M. Wilson, chairman, yesterday recommended appropriating \$1000 for use of the Jackson County Humane Society, in either the purchase of a suitable site, or construction of a building. The finance committee, composed of E. M. Wilson, R. B. Hammond, Charles A. Wing and Eugene Thorndyke, also explicitly

state that approval of the planning commission is imperative in the project. The Humane Society, after considerable shuttling about, has secured a site on the Pacific Highway, in front of the county fair buildings. Last December, the land appraisal committee and the parks and playground committee of the city council, also approved a site on the Barnsburg road, because of its proximity to the city. The new site, in the opinion of the members of the council committees, has the same objectionable features, as the former one. Any further action on the present angle of the dog pound issue rests with the city planning commission, and the \$1000 appropriation is contingent and dependent upon that body's approval. The council is in sympathy with the purposes of the Humane Society, but oppose conflict with city beautiful objectives.
