

WHEAT CROP FOR CURRENT SEASON SHOWS DECREASE

WASHINGTON, May 10.—(AP)—Estimate of production of winter wheat this year, as indicated from the condition of the crop May 3, was announced today by the department of agriculture as 525,670,000 bushels, compared with 578,836,000 bushels harvested last year, and 550,636,000 bushels, the 10-year average production.

LUMBER TARIFF VOTE SOUGHT FROM SENATE

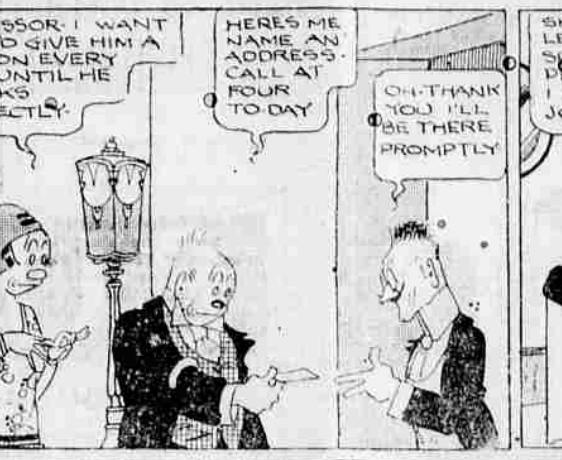

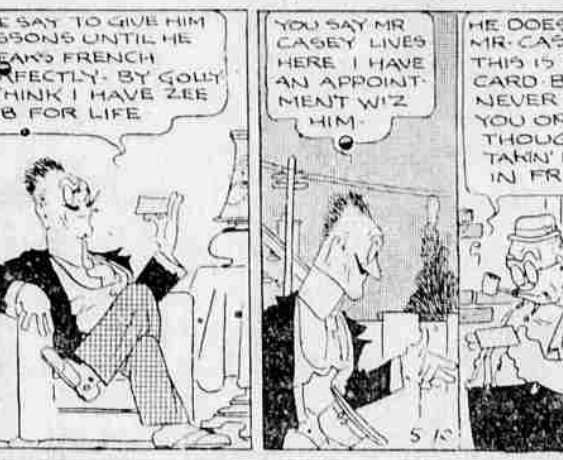

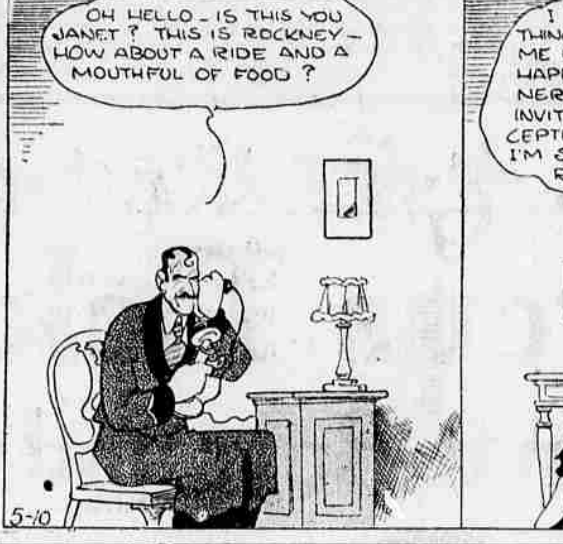
