

RUM AUTOS SUBJECT TO LIEN RIGHT ZEP HEADS FOR FIELD AT SEVILLE

Supreme Court Holds Cars Cannot Be Confiscated Until Prosecution Begun—Gives Financing Companies Chance to Recover

WASHINGTON, May 19.—(AP)—The Supreme Court held today that automobiles seized for illegally transporting liquor cannot be confiscated under the internal revenue laws where prosecution has not begun.

The court in cases from North Carolina and California decided the government prior to proceedings against those arrested must proceed under the prohibition laws against the automobile.

This would give lien holders an opportunity to recover the cars.

Decisions had been given in previous cases that after those using a seized automobile had been convicted under the prohibition law the automobile must be confiscated under the law.

The Richbourg Motor company of western North Carolina and the Davies Motors, Inc. in a case arising at Fresno, Cal., contended, without success, in the lower federal courts that even though those using the seized automobile had not been convicted under the prohibition law, proceedings to confiscate the automobile must be brought under that law when the seizure had been made on the charge of illegal transportation.

Overnight Stop Planned for Transfer of Passengers Before Trans-Atlantic Flight Begins—West Landfall Rio Janeiro.

TANGHIEL, Morocco, May 19.—(AP)—The dirigible Graf Zeppelin, bound for Seville on the first lap of her South American flight, passed over Tangier this afternoon. She was headed southward along the coast and it was thought she would swing northerly toward Seville shortly.

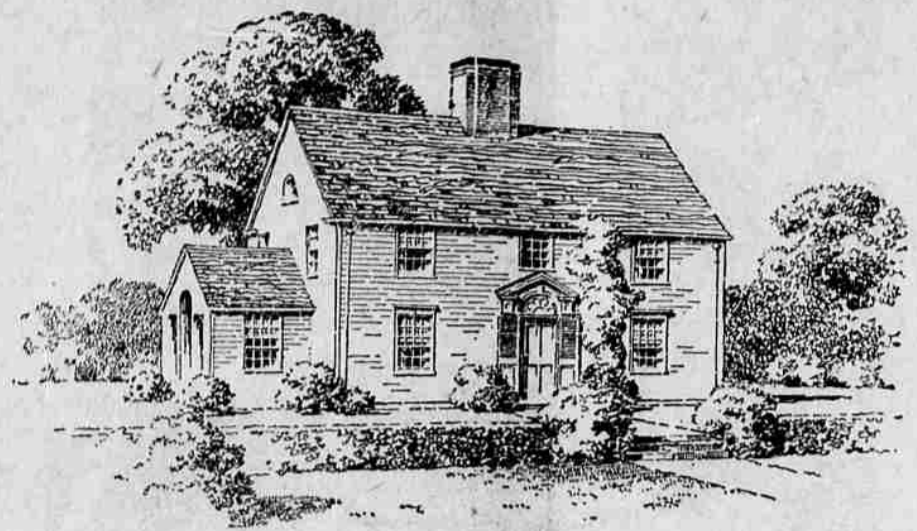
FRIEDRICHSHAFEN, Germany, May 19.—(AP)—The Graf Zeppelin sped southward today toward Seville, Spain, where it will stop overnight before continuing across the Atlantic and the equator to Pernambuco and Rio Janeiro, Brazil.

Before returning to Friedrichshafen, three weeks or more from now, Dr. Hugo Eckener, the ship's master, hopes to traverse about 18,000 miles—a jaunt second in scope only to the Graf's circumnavigation of the globe last fall. From Rio Janeiro the craft will fly to Havana and Lakehurst, starting the return trans-Atlantic trip from the latter port.

Of the 22 passengers aboard, six will disembark at Seville, to make room for others who will fly to Rio Janeiro, among those boarding the ship at Seville will be Mrs. Mary Pierce of New York, whose persistence in making the unlucky trans-Atlantic trip of last May against the wishes of her family almost brought diplomatic intervention.

CONTINUE SEARCH FOR LOST OAKLAND JUDGE

Predicts a Democratic Governor

The result of the primaries can be directly traced to Hoover "prosperity." As prosperity absorbs all criticism of the party in power and makes it invincible, adversity works the other way—it gives the mass of voters a grievance and something to vote against and they take it out at the polls. This is the basic reason for Mr. Joseph's success—he was "agin the government."

There was, of course, other causes. Mr. Joseph understands the rules of politics better than his opponents and plays the game unscrupulously. He had the better organization and the biggest slush fund. He put on a better show, furnished the most excitement, amused instead of boring, injected bitter personalities and appealed to prejudice. His power trust issue, as the source from which all evils flow, provided a straw man which he as lustily thumped as Big Bill Thompson, also a master showman, thumped King George.

Mr. Joseph possesses the ability to dramatize himself and his issue—which is worth any amount of arguments, statistics and facts. Mr. Norblad also had a touch of dramatic ability—but he lacked the imagination to fake an issue. Mr. Corbett lacked the ability to romanticize politics and common sense, brains and character do not appeal to the multitude in such a campaign.

These political turnovers come periodically and are really the safety valves of democracy, and keep it from blowing up in revolution. The radicals promising the rainbow are tried out and then when demagogic futility fails to bring the millennium, they are in turn ejected and for a long period, with returning prosperity, conservatives return to power.

One outcome seems certain—a minority candidate has been chosen for the Republicans and the conservative majority will not support him under any conditions, for they distrust him. The party is split and torn in factional fights as never before. Despite organization and money, the chances are that Oregon will have a Democratic governor.—George Putnam in Salem Capital-Journal.
