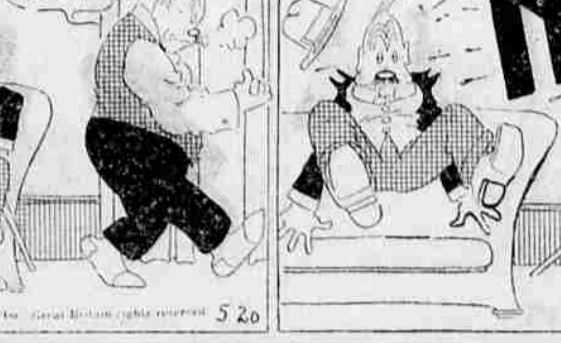

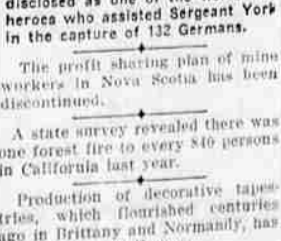

The investigators would then inquire if it was not quite irregular to make out a check to "Cash" instead of to a specific person, and if, as a matter of fact, Father was not attempting to conceal the purchase of tobacco by entering it in the budget under "Miscellaneous." Did he not hope thereby to escape the accusation of smoking too much? Father would decline to answer, on the ground that such evidence might incriminate himself.

The investigators would then issue subpoenas to the tobaccoist and the garden concern to appear next day with all their records, while public opinion would hold that though Father may not have been actually guilty of criminal operations, his actions appear highly suspicious. — (Baltimore Sun)
