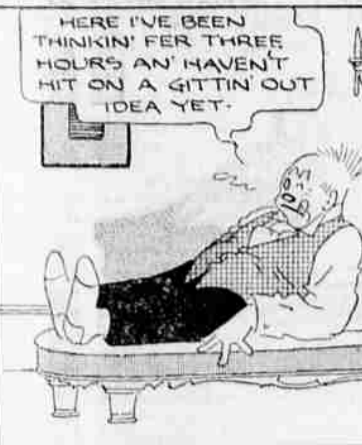
TILLAMOOK CHEESE ON LOWER PRICE LEVELS

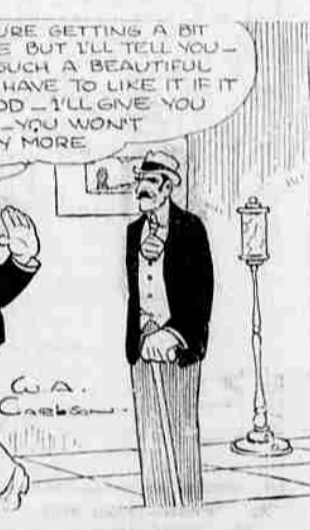
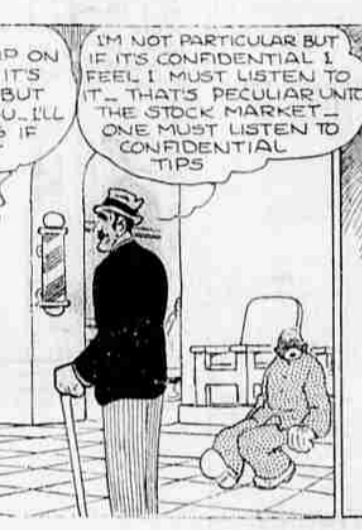
