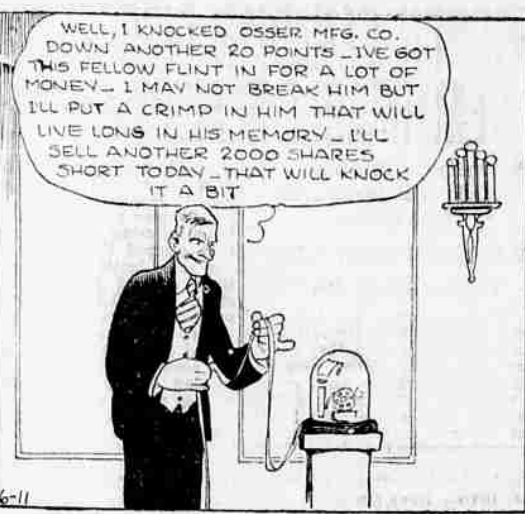
Oregon Weather
