

POSTPONE BEGINNING RAIL LINK

I. C. C. Grants Delay to January 1 for Work on Line From Crane to Crescent Lake—Appeal From Order Cause of Action.

WASHINGTON, June 20.—(AP)—The interstate commerce commission today postponed from July 1 to January 1 the date on which a Union Pacific subsidiary would be required to begin 185 miles of new railroad in Oregon, in view of the appeal against the order taken to the Oregon district court.

The litigation involves a test of a novel use of interstate commerce commission power and is being watched with more than ordinary concern by all railroad interests.

The precedent-creating decision of the commission resulted from a complaint instituted by Oregon which asked that the Union Pacific through the Oregon-Washington Railroad and Navigation company, which it owns, be required to build an east and west line directly across Oregon from Crane to Crescent Lake.

The cost of the construction was placed at about \$15,000,000 and the railroad protested sharply, challenging the authority of the government to force it to make any such involuntary investments of new capital. After a protracted contest, the commission, notwithstanding, ruled the line was needed and that the railroad was able to meet the cost. Thereafter the railroad entered the federal court to continue its resistance, and the commission's order to day granted the delay to allow the appeal to proceed.

STORY 1

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Great Northern should permit the Western Pacific to have reasonable joint use of a part of the new construction the company will undertake.

200 Mile Gap

The construction program approved will result in the Great Northern building 90 miles south from Klamath Falls, Oregon, while the Western Pacific will build 110 miles north from a point on its main line in Lassen county, the two extensions to meet.

The principal importance of the proposed line is as a bridge or connecting link between systems, the commission said. "This is true whether judged from the standpoint of prospective earnings or diversions of traffic from other lines. The new line will aid in the development of a great timber area and some considerable agricultural areas in northern California.

"The local traffic would probably be insufficient to justify a line built to the standards here proposed; but considering all traffic available the applicants have reasonable prospect of earning a fair return of their investment. Compared with the benefits which will accrue to the people of the Pacific west and northwest through the establishment of new competitive routes stimulating the interchange of products, the advantage of a diversified car supply, additional passenger service and the development of the local territory, the moderate capital expenditure here proposed seems amply justified.

Diversion Incidental

"The diversion of traffic from other lines will be principally due to the establishment of a direct connection between the systems of the applicants and must be regarded as incidental to and a necessary consequence of the removal of the bar to the unobstructed flow of traffic between them.

"These losses may be overcome in a few years by the rapid growth of the country and will not be sufficient to impair the ability of the applicants to perform their duty to the public."

"Though the law allows the commission under certain conditions to let railroads retain excess earnings from new construction for a period of ten years, in this building program that privilege was denied. In view of some considerations affecting the exact locations of the line southward from Klamath Falls, the opinion suggested that the Great Northern might obtain joint use of 24 miles of the Southern Pacific line out of that city, and save about \$800,000 in construction costs.

"The decision suggested that a supplemental application might be presented on that point if the railroads came to an agreement.

Approve Log Line Buy

The purchase of a short line of logging road in northern California incidental to the main construction by the Great Northern also was approved.

Describing the condition imposed, the commission said the certificate issued would require that "the Great Northern shall grant the Western Pacific on just and reasonable terms the right to operate over its proposed line between the terminal at Bieber and the turn out switch of the proposed joint line at or near Look-out."

STATE EDITORS TO BE GUESTS AT GUARD CAMP

Will Watch Night Machine Gun Demonstration — High Army Officers Inspecting Camp.

CAMP CLATSOP, Ore., June 20.

—(AP)—Newspaper men from all over Oregon tonight will learn about both social and military phases of the military at Camp Clatsop. The State Editorial association will be entertained by Major General George A. White and his staff at a dinner and dance.

During the evening the guests will be escorted to places of vantage where they may watch a night machine gun demonstration staged under the direction of Major Frederick L. Weiland, 162nd Infantry. The big chiefs were in camp today. Major John L. Hines, commander, ninth corps area; Major General W. G. Emerson, chief of the militia bureau, and Brigadier General Windsor, 41st division, field artillery brigade, made their rounds of the camp.

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The auction was pooled in order that no particular shipper would suffer in case the trade at first discounted ripened Boses. This, of course, involves the co-operation of all the shippers of the Medford district.

"The ripening charges would be paid by the shipper or grower or in the case of carlot receiver who owned the car outright, the charges would be absorbed by him.

"In return for these considerations the Medford Winter Pear committee agrees to put on an advertising program over two radio stations and also to put on a small dealer's service campaign, the purpose of same being to educate all wholesalers, large chain store buyers and large retail stores to the advantages of ripening Bose pears.

"Chicago, as you all know, is a fairly well developed market, but in view of its population, which the 1930 census shows to be 2,600,000, there is no doubt whatever that Chicago could absorb 250 carloads of Boses or more each and every year. As I understand it, Chicago has never taken beyond 130 carloads."

The Detroit program is as follows:

"Shipment of 75 cars Bose pears to Detroit, Michigan. Shippers and growers to use their own is-bels. This, in order to give every shipper or grower represented a break in favor of his package, should it merit the attention of the trade. Also, the committee considers it a good idea to have the trade, in all new cities developed, have a definite knowledge of the various brands originating from Medford, Oregon.

"All shipments to Detroit, Mich., this year will be pooled according to sizes, there being no guaranty of New York prices. Naturally, the pool will be based according to grades and sizes.

"Each shipper's proportion of the tonnage consigned to Detroit, Mich., will be determined by the volume of fruit he represents for account of the subscribers to the funds of the Winter Pear committee.

"Charges for ripening in Detroit this year will be 4 cents per box when the cars so ripened have been placed in storage in Detroit. When the cars are rolled direct from storage from Medford and handled for ripening only, the charge will be 10 cents per box. Ripening charges in every case will be absorbed by the grower or shipper as the case may be."

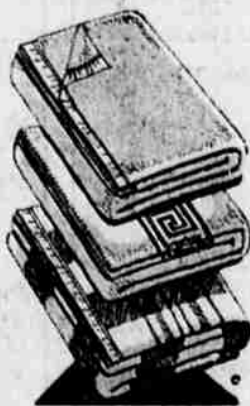
