LAWRENCE RUKES WINS LONG FIGHT AS DISABLED VET

Announcement that the United States Veterans' bureau has finally held that the affliction of Lawrence Rukes, blind war veteran, now at a government hospital at Palo Alto, Cal., is a service connected disability entitling Rukes to compensation, is received by Medford people with considerable interest and approval as Rukes is a former resident of this city and known by many friends. He is the son of Mr. and Mrs. Lew Rukes of 424 Peach street and played in the local basketball team for several years. The government has rated him as permanently and totally disabled. The Sunday Oregonian gives the following information on the case: "The case of Rukes, once a musician and music teacher of Portland, has aroused wide interest among Portland's war veterans who interested the national rehabilitation committee of the American Legion and Senator Steiwer when Rukes' blindness was caused by a brain tumor, which various medical boards at Portland, San Francisco and Washington refused to admit was due to military service. "New evidence was submitted several months ago to the Portland rating board, which held the disability to be service-connected, but both the appeals board at San Francisco and the appellate board at Washington decided adversely. The board and made a final demand for a ruling favorable to Rukes, which resulted in a reversal of the previous decision."
