SCOUTS LEAVING ON LAKE OUTING EARLY TUESDAY

Forty Medford boys will leave at 7:30 in the morning for Lake of the Woods where they will spend two weeks at the new scout camp, the first period opening at that time and continuing until July 22. About fifteen will be at the camp from Klamath Falls troops, and Phoenix and Ashland will also be represented.

The water system at the lake has been completed and running water has been placed in the kitchen. A wash room is now being built, and will be completed as soon as camp opens.

In addition to the regular scouting program, which includes cooking, tracking, and first aid instruction will be given in handicraft, archery, leathercraft, and marksmanship.

A diving raft has been built, and boats obtained for the season. Swimming will be in charge of a certified senior examiner who has passed the Red Cross tests. The boys must check in and out of the water, going in couples, and if one boy checks in, his partner must also come out of the water.

Physical examinations were given all of the boys by Drs. R. W. Slesinger and R. W. Stearns.

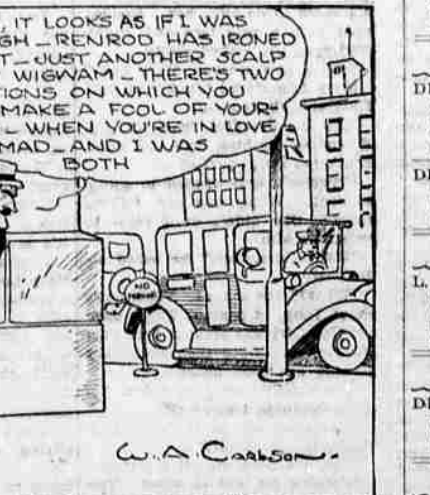
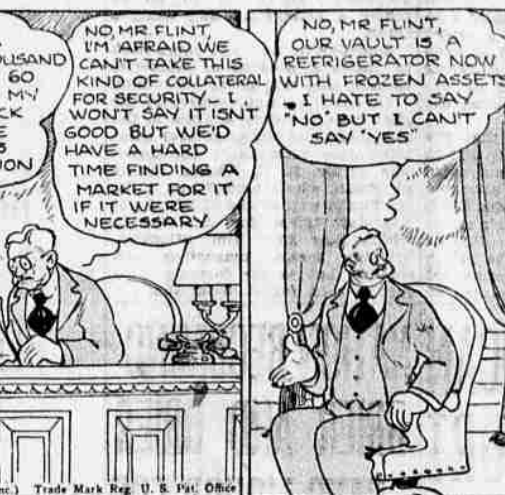
