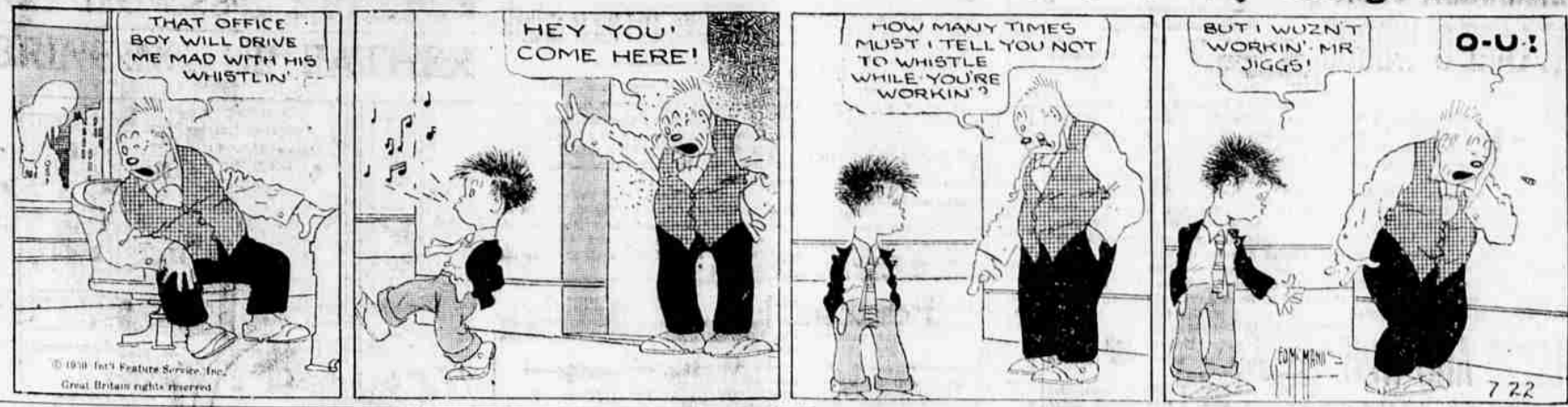

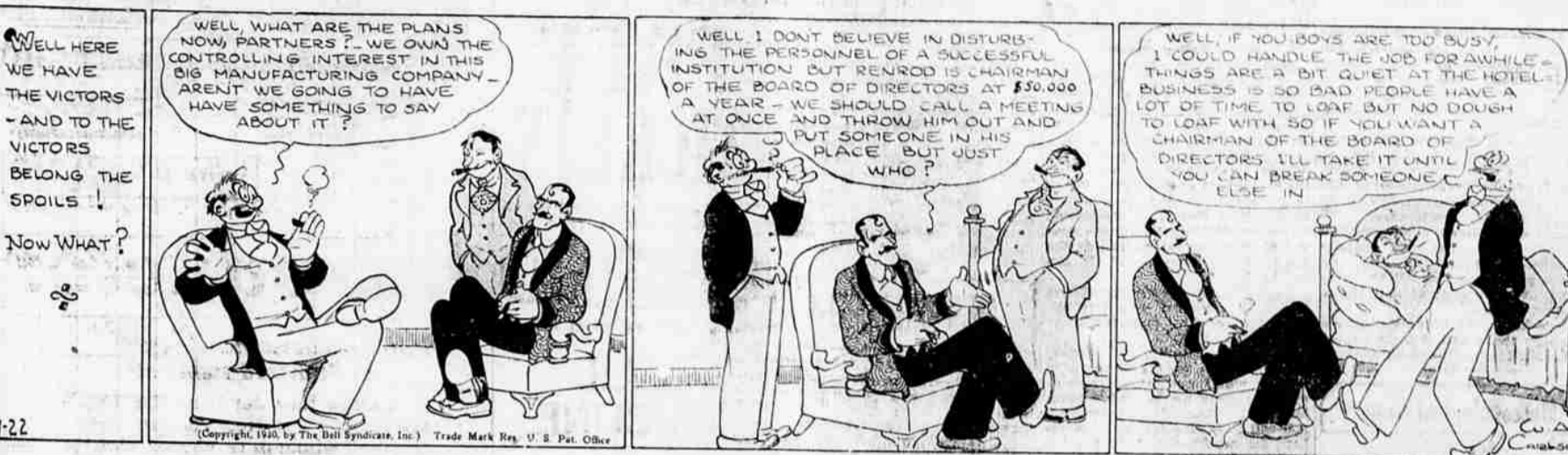
If, from time to time, you have any reading matter available for applying to your activities in connection with this humane work, will be glad to receive it. With best wishes,
