

# BIG TARIFF PARTY WINS IN CANADA

### Conservative Proponents of Protective Duty Overthrows MacKenzie King Liberal Government in General Election Vote.

OTTAWA, Ont., July 29.—(AP)—After 12 years in power the liberal government of W. L. MacKenzie King has been overthrown. The Conservative party, headed by Richard Bedford Bennett, won a majority of seats in the house of commons in yesterday's general election.

When MacKenzie King submits his resignation to the governor general, the prime minister will be Bennett, a lawyer who has practiced for years in Calgary and was born and educated in Nova Scotia. He has been Conservative leader three years. He is 49 years old and wealthy. The time of the change is not definite as an outgoing ministry is given opportunity to adjust its affairs.

Victory for the Conservatives, traditional proponents of a high protective tariff, was forecast early by an almost unprecedented upset in Quebec, Liberal stronghold.

### Five Defeated

Live Liberal ministers were defeated: Charles Dunning, minister of finance, whose last budget included tariff reprisals against the United States; T. A. Creer, minister of railways; Lucien Cannon, solicitor; Cyrus MacMillan, minister of fisheries; and W. F. Kay, minister without portfolio. Ten women sought seats, but Agnes C. MacPhail, the first woman to enter Canada's house of commons, alone was elected. She has held her district since 1921.

The tenure of office of MacKenzie King, educated at Harvard, had been featured by cordial relations with the United States.

After making one successful flight her Kitty-Hawk plane swerved and hit another while taxiing for another take-off. Both ships were damaged but within an hour Miss Du Pont had a new propeller and right wheel put on her plane and took the air again.

## YOUNG CUDAHY PARALYZED BY BOOTLEG RUM

LOS ANGELES, Cal., July 29.—(AP)—Michael Cudahy, son of the wealthy Chicago packing family, today is recovering from paralysis of his lower limbs, the result, physicians said, of drinking poisonous liquor.

Mrs. J. P. Cudahy, young Cudahy's mother, admitted last night her son was suffering from "what the doctors diagnose as poison liquor." She said he became ill after going to a party at a Hollywood hotel Friday morning.

## CHILOQUIN SLAYER CITES MIND ILLS

KLAMATH FALLS, Ore., July 29.—(AP)—The second day of the trial of Winfield H. Cahill, charged with first degree murder, opened today with cross examination of the defendant. Cahill is charged with killing Alfred ("Billy") Huff, boxer, March 23, at Chiloquin.

Losses of memory which Cahill is alleged to have suffered occasionally have been stressed by the defense. He testified yesterday he was afraid of Huff and thinks he did no wrong.

A war veteran, Cahill said he owned a box factory at Tacoma, had a lapse of memory and found himself in Portland. He doesn't know what happened to the factory.

## LABORER SLAYS WOMAN AND COMMITS SUICIDE

FRESNO, Calif., July 29.—(AP)—Mrs. Minnie Washburn, 36, of Alameda, was shot and killed in a ranch home near Reedley last night by Joe Sante, 44, itinerant laborer who then turned the gun on himself, dying several hours later.

Frances Mitchell, niece of the dead woman and a witness to the killing, said a quarrel preceded the shooting.

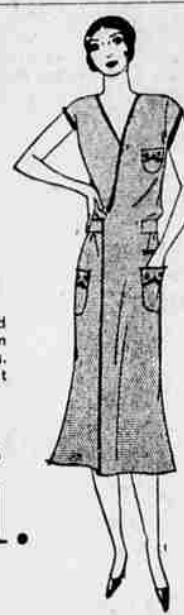
