HARD QUESTIONS FIRED AT SENIORS
Who was Hannibal? Is a tariff a tax on exports? Who said "Don't Give Up the Ship"? Fifty questions on social science, mathematics, physical science, English usages, and spelling were given all seniors in Medford high school this afternoon. The tests, drawn up by department heads in the school, were designed to find out how much knowledge the seniors have of fundamentals taught in school. Another test will be given in the spring and a comparison made of the two to see if progress has been made by the students. These tests will also be used in determining senior ratings covering their academic grades over their four years of high school.
