TURKEYS ADVANCE CENT IN PORTLAND AS SUPPLY WANES

PORTLAND, Ore., Dec. 17.—(AP) Portland wholesale turkey market stood at 29 cents for No. 1 birds today, a cent advance attained when dealers late Tuesday felt a stronger demand through consumer channels with supplies of freshly killed birds all but cleaned up here.

Wholesale butter and egg quotations opened unchanged but trade was slacker for both. A weakening factor for butter were 2 and 1 cent price declines in Los Angeles and San Francisco respectively, cutting attractiveness of those markets for shipping cubes from the northwest.

Fresh fruits and vegetables were selling at steady prices.

Portland creamery buying prices for grade "B" milk stood revised downward. Some creameries which had been paying up to \$2.50 a cwt., established new prices at \$2.30 for a volume of delivery up to a five months' average and \$1.60 for excess delivery while other creameries had paid \$2.25 a cwt. formerly quoted a new price at \$2.10. Grade "C" price was left unchanged at \$1.70.
