INHERITANCE TAX SHOWS DECLINE

SALEM, Ore., Jan. 3.—(AP)—State inheritance taxes received by State Treasurer Kay for the year 1929 aggregate \$1,165,294.12. Kay said today that of this amount \$779,950 is from receipts of estates on which settlement has been completed, and \$385,344.12 is uncollected pending other litigation. Receipted taxes are about \$30,000 less than for 1928, but total collections show an increase of about \$400. The cost of collections was \$12,919.25, about 1.14 per cent of the receipted items. Whatever future history may say of Mussolini it must admit that his country was fortunate in getting him for a ruler, at a time when the choice was dictatorship or chaos. Imagine Italy or Russia, without a powerful central government. The American Society of Naturalists discusses "the future of man in the light of his past." If you judged man by his past, full of murder, cheating, cannibalism, brutality, selfishness, you wouldn't hope much for his future. He must be judged by his progress. William F. Ogburn, University of Chicago, says that man of the future may remain a child until forty years old. Many do that now, and long after forty. Dr. Ogburn thinks morality, as we understand it, will disappear, and law will become less and less important. He is mistaken about morality. Respect for law will be inborn, so that men will do what they ought to do, as ants and bees do now, being millions of years older than we are. In the year 2,500, according to Dr. East of Harvard, the earth will be inhabited by one hybrid race, a mixture of all races, stabilized and permanent. That, however, will not happen by the year 2,500 or by the year 5,000. Men have been on the earth already for 40 million years, according to Professor Osborn of the Museum of Natural History. 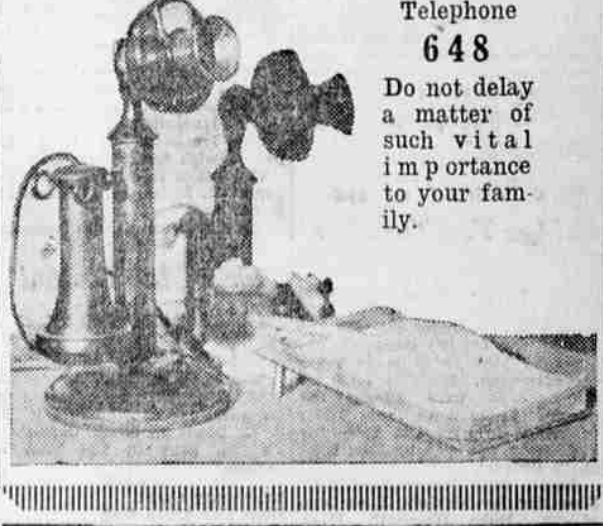
