PRICES LOWERED ON ALFALFA HAY IN SLOW DEMAND

PORTLAND, Jan. 21.—(P)—T. S. No. 1 alfalfa hay was quoted to the trade at \$17.00 to 18.00 a ton in Portland today, a 50 cents to \$1.00 decline from prices of a week ago and a reflection of continued slow demand reported by representatives of the department of agricultural economics throughout the northwest. F. o. b. prices in the Hornum district were reported around \$12.00.

PORTLAND, Jan. 21.—(P)—Butter and egg quotations held unchanged in wholesale markets today.

Butter market at the opening stood on firm ground in its relation of receipts to demand. Receipts were light and demand unusually good, promising a good clean-up of fresh supplies.

Egg market opened easy, receipts greater than demand, sales forced at irregular prices. Pacific coast extras a cent lower at New York was a weakening factor on the shipping side.

Country meats and poultry were steady except for a cent decline on medium weight hens, in oversupply; quote: 14 to 15 cents a pound. Fresh fruit and vegetable trade opened normally active at unchanged quotations on all lines.

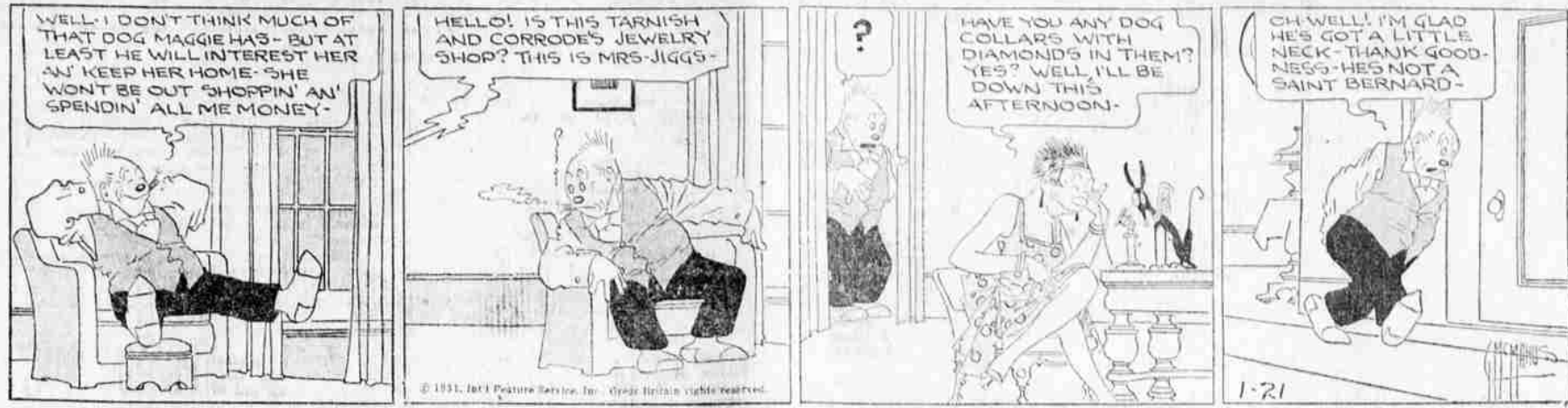
