YOUNG MEN ENTRUSTED WITH AKRON

New Navy Airship Will Be Ruled by Ten Officers Selected for Experience and Ability—Average Age 34 — 63 On Crew List

WASHINGTON — (AP) — Flying days of the navy airship Akron will be ruled by men who found the lure of the open sky stronger than the call of the sea.

Ten officers, sea salts once, but now experts in an aerial field, head the crew selected to man the monster dirigible that is expected first to fly in mid-summer.

To their task they will bring the daring and quickness of youth—their average age is 34—tempered with the experience and judgment of years aloft and aloft.

As captain there is Lieut. Comm. Charles E. Rosendahl, 39, slim, studious leader, quiet but direct of speech, on whom will rest the full responsibility for the \$5,375,000 air queen.

GITZEN APPOINTED STOCK INSPECTOR

SALEM, June 23.—(AP)—Stock inspectors for the 36 counties in Oregon were announced today by Max Gehlar, to enforce all live stock quarantine regulations and to inspect livestock shipped in and out of the counties. Their terms are for two years and their salaries ranging from \$25 to \$800 a year, paid by the counties.

The list of inspectors includes: G. A. Gitzen, Medford; Charles O. Gordon, Grants Pass, and A. T. Langell, Klamath Falls.

age was split on a three-four basis.

Increases Shown. He pointed out that whereas enrollments at the state college have increased only 1.1 per cent since 1921, they have increased 33 per cent at the university during this period. Oregon State claims it costs much more for each student in technical courses, but the university claims that the disparity is altogether too great. The state spends approximately \$207 per student at the university, but \$269 at the college.

Sammons said that his committee had heard voluminous statistical arguments from both sides on that point, that both sides had interpreted figures in an entirely different light and that for this reason the committee felt the matter should be opened for future studies and adjustments on actual enrollments and costs.

One step toward this adjustment is the board's adoption of a central accounting office at Salem. Sammons said this would not abolish the local offices needed to collect student tuitions and fees and to control local expenditures and work, but that it would make it possible for the board to effect
