Gateway of Auburn Prison Closed To Women Felons As Those of Bedford Open

ALBANY, N. Y. — (UP) — July 1 marked the beginning of the end of Auburn state prison for women, present home of "Cat-Eye Annie" McDowell and other internationally known criminals of her sex, after more than 45 years' service.

At Bedford they will have more liberties. The prison atmosphere will be less oppressive—if their behavior is good. They will live in cottages and dormitories. And when they are released it will be easier for them to "go straight." That is the hope of Dr. Walter N. Thayer, commissioner of correction, and his department. Incorrigibles like "Cat-Eye Annie," of course, will be given no more latitude than they deserve. "Cat-Eye" is quite a jail-breaker. She is almost as adept at that as at gem thieving. She escaped twice from Auburn, which is no mean feat, and once from Erie county jail in Buffalo. On each occasion she was recaptured within 24 hours.

ANIMATED MAP OF NATIONAL PARK IS CALIFORNIANS AIM

CRATER LAKE — (Special) — Two Californians of prominence, L. O. Head, vice-president of the San Francisco chamber of commerce, and Ralph Phelps of San Francisco, member of the California State Parks council, paid their first visits to the Crater Lake National park this week. Both men were accompanied by their families. Mr. Phelps, combining business with pleasure, visited the lake while on a trip to northern California and southern Oregon in connection with the acquisition of a state park, of the Mill creek grove of redwood trees in Del Norte county, near Crescent City. The grove covers an area of 23,000 acres and is well-known as a scenic attraction. The trees average about 1800 years in age. He plans to return to Crater Lake in a month with Jo Mora, national sculptor and artist, to make an animated map of the park, such as Mr. Mora has already made of Yellowstone, Yosemite and Grand Canyon. He has plans for making such maps of all national parks. Mr. Phelps was accompanied to the lake by Mrs. Phelps and daughters, Virginia and Shirley.

Good Insulation Is Vital Factor in Refrigerator

To their own regret too many purchasers of electric refrigerators fail to realize or take into consideration the vital part insulation plays in the operation of a modern refrigerator, declares C. H.
